To Whom It May Concern:

I am submitting a complaint against the El Paso Children's Hospital based on a number of allegations and our own experiences. Our complaint should be considered a high priority quality incident of immediate and serious concern for The Office of Quality Monitoring. We are not alone in our concerns; various local pediatricians have also brought this to the attention of CEO Cindy Stout and the El Paso Children's Hospital Board of Directors.

We are doing this for our community because we don't want any more children to die, and we certainly don't want any more parents to live through what we have experienced. El Paso deserves a world-class children's hospital. That is what we want. We want administrators and doctors who care about healthcare and not just making a profit. Our children need quality care, right now, and the injustice needs to stop immediately.

Beyond a written response from the El Paso Children's Hospital to this complaint, I am requesting a forcause, unannounced and unscheduled, survey to be conducted as soon as possible.
