I hope that this letter finds you and your Federation's staff safe and healthy.

Further to our Circular Letter n° 26 informing you about adjustments to the FIBA Calendar approved by the FIBA Executive Committee, we are pleased to inform you that our discussions with the International Olympic Committee (IOC) regarding the exact date of the Olympic Qualifying Tournaments (OQTs) have concluded successfully.

Specifically, FIBA has received today confirmation that the adaptation to the Qualification Period Timeline requested by FIBA has been approved by the IOC Executive Board Taskforce. Therefore, the outstanding 4 (four) Olympic Qualification Tournaments will be played between **June 29 and July 4, 2021**.

This exceptional IOC approval in favour of FIBA, considering that the general Qualification Deadline announced by the IOC for all Summer Olympic sports is 29 June 2021, was the result of a lengthy consultation process with the IOC, in which the players' workload, the national team preparation and the national league calendars were considered.

The FIBA Sport and Competitions department remains at your entire disposal regarding the details (registration, etc.) for these events. In the meantime, I remain
