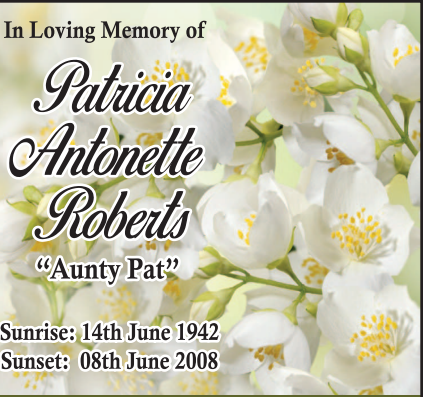




In Loving Memory of
