TAKE NOTICE that the Claimant, Veronica Alexander has commenced an action against you the First and Second Defendants in the High Court of Justice, The Waterfront Judicial Centre, Tower D, International Waterfront Centre, 1A Wrightson Road, Port of Spain Trinidad and Tobago by way of Claim Form and Statement of Case **Claim No. CV2025-04531** filed on the 06th day of November, 2025, in which it claims the following reliefs: -

1. A declaration that the Claimant is the owner of All and Singular that certain piece or parcel of land in the Ward of Arima, Olton Road, together with the buildings standing thereon by virtue of Deed No. 8317 of 1994.
2. A declaration that the Claimant has extinguished the 1st Defendant's entitlement/rights to the piece or parcel of land on which her house encroaches onto the 1st Defendant's land along with a curtilage of four (4) feet.
3. A declaration that the recent renovations of the 2nd Defendant has trespass onto the Claimant's property.
An injunction restraining the Defendants whether by themselves, their agents, servants or whosoever otherwise from interfering with the Claimant's quiet possession of Lot No. 12 and the area encroached upon from Lot No. 14.
4. An injunction compelling the 1st Defendant to immediately repair the staircase on the Claimant's property that was destroyed by the 1st Defendant her servants and/or agents.
5. An injunction compelling the 2nd Defendant to immediately remove the additional structure that further encroached onto the Claimant's property.
6. Damages for trespass to property and for nuisance.
7. Aggravated and/or exemplary damages.
8. Costs and Interest.
9. Such further or other relief as the Court deems just and expedient.

ALSO TAKE NOTICE that on the 12th day of January, 2026, the Honourable Madam Justice Margaret Mohammed ordered that:-

1. Permission is granted to the Claimant to effect service of these proceedings upon the 2nd Defendant by way of Notice advertised in a daily newspaper of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago for a period of once per week for two (2) consecutive weeks.
2. The Application seeking permission to serve the Claim Form and Statement of Case outside of the jurisdiction is refused.
3. The Application seeking permission to serve the 1st Defendant by email address wacklind@yahoo.com or by WhatsApp to phone number 1-9170604-0293 is refused.
4. No order as to cost.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that on the 31st day of March, 2026 the Honourable Madam J. Margaret Mohammed ordered that: -

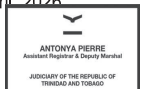
1. Time is extended for the Claimant to serve the Defendants with the Claim Form and Statement of Case to 31st July, 2026.
2. Permission is granted to the Claimant to effect service of these proceedings upon the 1st Defendant by way of Notice advertised in a daily newspaper of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago for a period of once per week for two (2) consecutive weeks.
3. The time for the Defendants to enter an Appearance is fourteen (14) days from the date of the last publication of the advertisement.
4. The time for the Defendants to file a Defence is Thirty-five (35) days from the date of the last publication of the advertisement.
5. No orders as to costs.

IF YOU desire to defend or admit this claim, you must enter an Appearance (Form 3) within fourteen (14) days and file a Defence (Form 5) within thirty-five (35) days, after the date of the last publication of the last advertisement, to the Claim Form and Statement of Case at any of the Court Offices of the Supreme Court, the Waterfront Judicial Centre, Tower D, International Waterfront Centre, 1A Wrightson Road, Port of Spain, Supreme Court Scarborough, Supreme Court 271 Naparima-Mayaro Road, Princess Town via the e-filing platform at <https://eservices.ttlawcourts.org/filing> or alternatively at the Court Office (Telephone Number: 224-5182/628-8529/235-2988).
