YOUNG LEADERS DONATE \$2,950 TO LOCAL FPD AND EMS

Members of the Clinton County Farm Bureau (CFB) Young Leader Committee had another good response for their 2026 Equipment Grant program, receiving five (5) applications that requested over \$15,000 in funding. In cooperation with an \$800 "Farm Safety Grant" from the Illinois Farm Bureau and COUNTRY Financial, all five were awarded grants ranging in value from \$500 to \$800, for a total of \$2,950 in funding for 2026.

To date, the Clinton CFB Young Leaders have awarded \$17,400 in grant funding through their FPD/EMS Grant Program.
