BEWARE OF SCAMS RELATED TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

In this time of uncertainty Scammers are taking advantage of fears surrounding COVID-19. Make sure you are aware of any suspicious activity. Hang up on unusual calls, ignore online offers and don't respond to texts/emails from companies claiming any abnormal activity on your accounts. Contact the Sheriff's Office at 540-347-3300 for any information regarding local scams.

Scam activity may include:

- Calls with offers of treatment, cures,
 vaccines or insurance for COVID-19.
- Online sales of high-demand medical supplies, such as surgical masks.
- Calls or emails demanding funds for treatment or other medical services.
- Solicitation of donations for those affected by COVID-19.

- **Health authorities** asking for personal or financial information.
- **Investments claiming** to detect, prevent or cure COVID-19 is a scam.
- Any offers of employment.
- Someone claiming to be
 Dominion Power, threatening to turn off your power.
