Members of the public who would like to provide comments to the Board of Supervisors at a regular public meeting of the Board are encouraged to do so remotely in keeping with the County's efforts to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus and protect the health, safety and welfare of the community.

# WebEx Virtual Meeting (Audio Only):

- Citizens may make comments directly to the Board of Supervisors remotely via the WebEx virtual meeting.
- Citizens who would like to participate in the meeting remotely require advance registration **no later than 12 noon the day of the meeting.**



- All virtual and telephone participants are required to pass a sound check prior to the start of the meeting. Please join the WebEx meeting with a computer or dial in by telephone between 5:30 PM - 5:45 PM on the day of the meeting.
- Once the Meeting Moderator has completed a sound check, the citizen will be muted until it is time for each citizen to speak. Please note that only verbal comment is available. Device cameras are disabled.
- When it is your turn to speak, please do not attempt to watch the
  livestream broadcast and speak through the WebEx meeting simultaneously.
  There is a delay between the actual meeting (WebEx) and the livestream
  broadcast (online or local cable) of the meeting.
- We recommend the use of earbuds or a headset when speaking to help eliminate background noise.
- Those not actively participating in the meeting via WebEx may view the livestream broadcast of the meeting by using the "Watch" options below.
- WebEx application and computer configuration instructions will be made available on this <u>webpage</u> prior to the public hearing.

#### In Person:

- Because of the CDC directive to limit gatherings of people in indoor locations, live citizen participation at the meeting location will be limited to those desiring to speak during Citizens' Time or during a scheduled public hearing.
- Citizens wishing to appear in person should arrive prior to the start time of the meeting. Upon arrival at the <u>Warren Green Building on 10 Hotel Street</u>, <u>Warrenton</u>, <u>VA 20186</u> you will receive additional direction.
- Please note that due to the pandemic there may be a wait time to speak. All
  citizens waiting will be outside of the building and are subject to social
  distancing requirements. All citizens speaking to the Board in person are
  required to wear masks or face coverings. Anyone without a mask will not
  be permitted to enter the building and anyone granted entry must wear a
  mask or face covering throughout the building as a public safety measure.
