NOMINATION INFORMATION

Two citizen meetings will be held for the purpose of accepting nominations of candidates for **Mayor** for the upcoming **Special Election** to be held on Tuesday, November 17, 2026. Nominations will remain open between the two meetings:

September 15, 2026 - First Nomination Meeting at 7:00 p.m., at the Mount Airy Town Hall, 110 S. Main Street, Mount Airy.

September 22, 2026 - Second Nomination Meeting at 7:00 p.m., at the Mount Airy Town Hall, 110 S. Main Street, Mount Airy – at the conclusion of which nominations will be closed.

To run for elected office as the Mayor qualified individuals shall have resided in the Town of Mount Airy for at least two years immediately preceding the election, must be at least 25 years of age and be a qualified voter in the Town.

Nominations will be accepted at both Nomination Meetings and by contacting Holly McDaniels, Town Clerk, at Town Hall, 301-829-1424 or via email at hmcdaniels@mountairymd.gov during the week between the two Nomination Meetings. Individuals seeking elective office may submit a nomination. Eligible citizens may nominate an individual with the written consent of the nominee.
