

Eastern Gas Transmission & Storage (EGTS) proposes Project Oak Leaf to increase the capacity of its PL-1 pipeline system to deliver incremental volume to serve end-use customers in Maryland and Virginia. The Project will leverage existing EGTS infrastructure while increasing capacity on its system through pipeline and compressor station additions.

Project Oak Leaf will include the following upgrades:

Compressor Station Upgrades

Install new compression at three (3) existing compressor stations

Modify/upgrade existing facilities at two (2) stations for improved efficiency

Measurement & Regulation (M&R) Stations

Construct one (1) new M&R station

Modify/upgrade three (3) existing M&Rs

Pipeline Installations

10.5 miles of 36" pipeline at Finnefrock South
(Clinton County, PA)

15.5 miles of 36" pipeline at Centre South
(Centre County, PA)

13.5 miles of 36" pipeline at Chambersburg South
(Franklin County, PA)

13 miles of 36" pipeline at Myersville South
(Frederick County, MD)

Regulatory approval for the project will be obtained via application to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act. EGTS expects to file the application with FERC in late 2026.
