

§ C3-7 Meetings of Commissioners.
[Amended 4-24-2019 by Res. No. 2019-01]

- A. The Commissioners shall meet regularly at such times their rules may prescribe, but not less than once each month. The Town Clerk may call special meetings upon the request of the Burgess or a majority of the Commissioners. All meetings shall be open to the public, except when the Maryland Open Meetings Act permits closed sessions. Residents of the town shall have a reasonable opportunity to be heard at any meeting in regard to any town question.
- B. Meeting ~~attendance~~ **PARTICIPATION** shall be allowed by method of telephone or video conference call format in the event that the Burgess or a Commissioner is unavailable to attend the meeting in person.
 - 1. The Burgess or Commissioner physically absent may join in discussion but is prohibited from casting a vote and will not be counted as present in regards to Charter § **C3-10**, determining a quorum, and § **C3-2C, compensation for absences**.
 - 2. **Anyone participating via telephone or video conference call pursuant to this section is also considered to have failed to attend the meeting as referenced in C6-2D, Forfeiture of office.**
- C. Exception: § **C3-7B** shall not apply to closed meetings.
