Subject: Formal Confirmation of Silhouette Donation to Platoon 22

This letter serves as formal written confirmation of the donation and transfer of the guardian silhouettes from Mission 22 to Platoon 22. Mission 22 was the donor organization, and Platoon 22 was the recipient organization of the silhouettes.

The silhouettes were created to honor Clay Ward and Ryan Thomas. The silhouettes provided to Platoon 22 were the interior cutouts from The War at Home Memorial and were donated to Platoon 22 as the designated guardian of these pieces.

Initial coordination regarding this project began through Danny Farrar, and the transfer process was then personally managed by Sara Johnson on behalf of Mission 22 and Niki Falzone on behalf of Platoon 22. The collaborative work related to the transfer lasted approximately 1 year, with email records reflecting active coordination in 2021 and formal confirmation by this letter in 2026.

Platoon 22 made the request for the silhouettes, and Mission 22 approved it after reviewing the proposal. Platoon 22 was solely responsible for coordinating pickup, careful transportation, and installation of the silhouettes.

The silhouettes were initially intended for and installed at the Veteran Services Center in Frederick, Maryland. It is expressly confirmed that this location was not a contingency of guardianship for Platoon 22.

Mission 22 confirms that Platoon 22's guardianship of the silhouettes is not contingent on their physical location or on any particular lease or premises. While the Veteran Services Center was the intended and initial installation site at the time of donation, it is understood that organizations sometimes relocate, and Platoon 22 is fully within its rights and duties to relocate the silhouettes and take them along with any future office moves.

If there was ever a time or reason that Platoon 22 could no longer be the guardians and owners of the silhouettes, it is understood that they would be returned to Mission 22.

Mission 22 nor Platoon 22 would never intend or want for these silhouettes to be left behind at a vacated property or to be treated as the property of a landlord or third party.

If additional confirmation is needed, this record may be relied upon as formal documentation of the donation and transfer.
