



ALL-COUNTY GIRLS SOCCER

Offensive Player of the Year BROOKE CLAGETT

OAKDALE SOPHOMORE FORWARD

Seemingly a threat to score anytime and anywhere she touched the ball in the offensive end of the field, Clagett notched 19 goals this season to lead Frederick County and finished with 4 assists. It felt like she could turn and score at any moment.

The attention she drew from opposing defenses opened up scoring opportunities for her teammates.

Clagett's offensive prowess helped the Bears finish with the best record in Frederick County girls soccer at 16-2-1. It helped them win Central Maryland Conference and Class 3A West regional titles for the second consecutive season, and it helped them reach the Class 3A state semifinals for the third season in a row.



Defensive Player of the Year MYA ALCALA

OAKDALE SENIOR DEFENDER

Bears coach Annie Schwarzenberg called Alcala "a rock for us" all season on the back line, where she often took on the challenge of defending the opposing team's best offensive players.

Thanks in large part to Alcala's efforts, Oakdale posted 14 shutouts this season, by far the most in Frederick County, and allowed only eight goals in 19 games.

Alcala's persistent work on the defensive end helped the Bears finish with the best record in Frederick County girls soccer at 16-2-1. It helped them win Central Maryland Conference and Class 3A West regional titles for the second consecutive season, and it helped them reach the Class 3A state semifinals for the third season in a row.



FIRST TEAM

RYLEIGH ALCALA JUNIOR FORWARD OAKDALE

Big, strong and athletic, Alcala gave the Bears a physical presence on the ball. She tallied 7 goals and 4 assists in helping them finish with the best record in Frederick County and reach the Class 3A state semifinals for a third straight season.



ADRIANA ARTIS FRESHMAN FORWARD FREDERICK

A dynamic offensive player, Artis came onto the high-school soccer scene in Frederick County and finished as one of the leading scorers. She finished with 7 goals and 2 assists and helped keep the Cadets competitive in most games.



CAROLINE ATWILL JUNIOR MIDFIELD OAKDALE

A very skilled offensive player, Atwill provided some punch for Oakdale's offensive attack with her precision strikes. She finished with 9 goals and 6 assists for a team that reached the Class 3A state semifinals for the third consecutive season.



NINA CONNORS SENIOR FORWARD TUSCARORA

The leading scorer in Frederick County for the second consecutive season, Connors overcame a torn labrum and managed to score 18 goals and 11 assists. She was named to the All-State first team by the Maryland Association of Coaches of Soccer.



ANA DAVIS SENIOR MIDFIELDER WALKERSVILLE

A strong force in the midfield along with twin sister Azrayiah, Davis helped the Lions finish the regular season with a 14-0 record. She tallied 8 goals and 6 assists for a team that reached a Class 2A West regional championship game.



AZRAYIAH DAVIS SENIOR MIDFIELDER WALKERSVILLE

One of three players to notch at least 40 points for the season in Frederick County, Davis finished with 18 goals and 4 assists for a Walkersville team that finished the regular season with a 14-0 record and reached a Class 2A West regional final.



ALLISON GEORGE JUNIOR DEFENSE BRUNSWICK

A dynamic all-purpose player, George provided an offensive spark from the back line for the Railroaders. She finished with 8 goals and 11 assists as one of the top goal scorers in Frederick County. That helped Brunswick reach the 1A state quarterfinals.



LAYKE JENSEN JUNIOR FORWARD BRUNSWICK

A top-five scorer in Frederick County for the second consecutive season, Jensen matched her goal scoring from the previous season with 15 and raised her assist total to 6, helping the Railroaders reach the Class 1A quarterfinals for the third straight season.



SAMANTHA MCDONOUGH SENIOR FORWARD WALKERSVILLE

A senior captain for the Lions who had a nose for the ball, McDonough finished as one of the top five scorers in Frederick County with 16 goals and 7 assists and helped the Lions cap an undefeated regular season at 14-0.



AUDREY MEADOWS JUNIOR MIDFIELDER LINGANORE

A steady presence in the middle of the field for the Lancers, Meadows made a difference on offense and defense for the Lancers. She finished with 3 goals and 2 assists for a team that reached a Class 3A West regional final.



CARA ROBELL JUNIOR GOALKEEPER OAKDALE

Once again the backbone of an Oakdale defense that seemed impenetrable, Robell posted 14 shutouts, which was the most in Frederick County by a wide margin. That helped the Bears reach the state semifinals for the third season in a row.



ELLA SHERIDAN SENIOR MIDFIELDER TUSCARORA

One of the leading scorers in Frederick County, Sheridan was named to the All-State first team by the Maryland Association of Coaches of Soccer. She finished with 14 goals and 6 assists for the Titans.



MORGAN SHERRILL SENIOR MIDFIELDER URBANA

A linchpin in the middle of the field for the Hawks, Sherrill was named to the All-State first team by the Maryland Association of Coaches of Soccer. She had 5 goals and 3 assists for the state quarterfinalists.



HALEY SMITH SENIOR FORWARD URBANA

A steady, reliable and consistent player, Smith tallied 10 goals on the season to lead Urbana. She also added a pair of assists. Her offensive prowess helped the Hawks reach the state quarterfinals in Class 4A.



AVA TAYLOR SENIOR FORWARD LINGANORE

Never afraid to dive into the middle of the action, Taylor led the Lancers with her play on the field and her personality. She finished with 10 goals and 6 assists to help them reach a Class 3A West regional final.
