

MEET THE 2026 FREDERICK KEYS



Cohen Achen (No. 19)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-2, 210
Born: 7/31/01

Hometown: Calgary, AB, Canada
How acquired: 14th-round pick in 2024

Skinny: Spent the majority of last season with High-A Aberdeen and pitched in 17 games with nine starts and three finishes. Accumulated a 3.70 ERA and pitched in 58.1 innings with a 5-8 record. Attended Lindsey Wilson College, an NAIA school.



Wehiwa Aloy (No. 25)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 6-2, 200
Born: 2/4/04

Hometown: Wailuku, Hawaii
How acquired: First-round pick in 2025

Skinny: The No. 5 rated Orioles prospect has power at the plate and range and smoothness in the field. The same year he won the Golden Spikes Award and SEC Player of the Year, the first-round pick joined Delmarva, where he hit .288 with a pair of homers, nine doubles and a triple in 20 games last season.



Leandro Arias (No. 38)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 6-1, 155
Born: 2/05/05

Hometown: Santiago, D.R.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2022

Skinny: Entering his fifth year with the organization, he played in 78 games last season for High-A Aberdeen. He hit .219 with two homers, 27 RBIs and eight doubles, spending time at second base, third base and shortstop for the IronBirds.



RJ Austin (No. 6)

Position: Outfielder
Height, weight: 5-11, 199
Born: 12/18/03

Hometown: Atlanta
How acquired: Third-round pick in 2024

Skinny: He joined Delmarva last August after getting drafted, playing in 18 games and hitting .263 with nine stolen bases. In his final season at Vanderbilt, he was a Rawlings Gold Glove winner. At the plate, he hit .257 with 15 doubles, four triples, two homers and 42 RBIs.



Boston Bateman (No. 50)

Position: Left-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-8, 240
Born: 9/20/05

Hometown: Henderson, Nev.
How acquired: Second-round pick in 2024 (San Diego)

Skinny: After arriving in a trade with the Padres, the Orioles' 9th-rated prospect split time between Aberdeen and Delmarva, putting together a 4.14 ERA over five total starts, all no-decisions. The son of an NFL offensive lineman, he has a fastball that lives in the low-to-mid 90s along with two breaking pitches.



Ryan Cabarcas (No. 28)

Position: Left-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 5-10, 180
Born: 4/24/01

Hometown: Pembroke Pines, Fla.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2024

Skinny: Finished his first season with the Orioles in 2025 after spending time with the Shorebirds and IronBirds in addition to rookie ball. Made 12 appearances with Aberdeen, going 1-1, recording two saves and striking out 24 across 16.2 innings.



Yeiber Cartaya (No. 54)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-5, 165
Born: 1/20/03

Hometown: Caracas, Venezuela
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2022

Skinny: Entering his fourth season with the Orioles, he went 3-4 and had 96 strikeouts over 78 1-3 innings over 19 games at Delmarva in 2025. Finished the season in Aberdeen, where he struck out 21 and walked 15 over 20 innings.



Eccel Correa (No. 49)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-0, 170
Born: 2/1/03

Hometown: La Habana, Cuba
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2023

Skinny: Spent time on three levels in 2025, including one start with Double-A Chesapeake, and finished with a combined ERA of 2.62. Threw 65 1-3 innings last season. He fanned 35 over 32 2-3 innings with the Shorebirds.



Jacob Cravey (No. 34)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-6, 215
Born: 9/28/01

Hometown: Andalusia, Ala.
How acquired: Sixth-round pick in 2023

Skinny: Started last season with Delmarva and pitched 68 2-3 innings with eight starts. Recorded 55 strikeouts and walked 27 before the call-up to Aberdeen. Made 10 appearances and two starts with the IronBirds, going 23 1-3 innings and fanning 25.



Elis Cuevas (No. 46)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 5-11, 150
Born: 11/08/04

Hometown: Azua, D.R.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2022

Skinny: Played 82 total games in 2025 with 50 of those in Delmarva. As a Shorebird, he finished with a .229 average, three homers and 20 RBIs, and was 19-of-22 in stolen bases. Swiped a total of 35 bases on the season.



Sayer Diederich (No. 40)

Position: Left-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-0, 190
Born: 10/10/00

Hometown: Omaha, Neb.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2025

Skinny: He appeared in 10 games, including one start, with Delmarva last season, going 1-2 over 27 1-3 innings with a 3.29 ERA. Struck out 39. Played in college at Nebraska and NAIA LSU-Shreveport.



Carson Dorsey (No. 18)

Position: Left-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-2, 180
Born: 2/25/03

Hometown: Panama City Beach, Fla.
How acquired: Seventh-round pick in 2024

Skinny: He battled injury early in the 2025 season before joining Delmarva and going 2-2 with a 4.04 ERA over 42 1-3 innings (10 starts). He struck out 58 and walked 17. Played in college at Florida State.



Joseph Dzierwa (No. 14)

Position: Left-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-8, 200
Born: 4/21/04

Hometown: Haskins, Ohio
How acquired: Second-round pick in 2025

Skinny: The 12th-rated Orioles prospect and a towering hurler, he did not appear in a game last season after getting drafted. He was Michigan State's ace for three seasons and was named the 2025 Big Ten Pitcher of the Year. Has an advanced fastball/change-up combo that comes from a three-quarters arm slot.



Victor Figueroa (No. 24)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 6-5, 240
Born: 12/31/03

Hometown: New Port Richey, Fla.
How acquired: 18th-round pick in 2024 (San Diego)

Skinny: Part of the trade-deadline deal with San Diego, he appeared in 25 games for Aberdeen in 2025. Finished with seven homers, 30 RBIs and a .262 average in 195 at-bats overall last season.



Nate George (No. 1)

Position: Outfielder
Height, weight: 6-0, 200
Born: 6/4/06

Hometown: Joliet, Ill.
How acquired: 16th-round pick in 2024

Skinny: The Brooks Robinson Minor League Player of the Year is the top-ranked prospect in the organization. He hit .337 with 28 extra-base hits in 87 games across three teams, rising to High-A Aberdeen from rookie ball. Also stole 50 bases in 75 attempts and ended with a .896 OPS.



Joe Glassey (No. 52)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-3, 220
Born: 7/17/01

Hometown: Lindenhurst, Ill.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2024

Skinny: Produced a 2.22 ERA over 24 1-3 innings in Delmarva last season, recording one save and 32 strikeouts. Was strictly a reliever in college at Illinois, where he was an academic All-American as a redshirt senior in 2024.



Vance Honeycutt (No. 7)

Position: Outfielder
Height, weight: 6-3, 205
Born: 5/17/03

Hometown: Salisbury, N.C.
How acquired: First-round pick in 2024

Skinny: The former first-rounder struggled in Aberdeen in his first full season of A ball, batting .171 with five homers and 24 RBIs in 101 games along with 32 steals. He clouted four longballs this spring in the Grapefruit League, showing his potential. He's a top-notch athlete and former ACC Defensive Player of the Year at North Carolina.



Ike Irish (No. 11)

Position: Outfielder
Height, weight: 6-2, 201
Born: 11/26/03

Hometown: Hudsonville, Mich.
How acquired: First-round pick in 2025

Skinny: The Orioles' fourth-rated prospect, he is an all-fields hitter and a coveted catching prospect who has layers of fielding versatility. He made his pro debut in Delmarva after starring at Auburn and getting drafted. He batted .230 over 20 games.



Chandler Marsh (No. 44)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-4, 245
Born: 9/6/02

Hometown: Wellington, Fla.
How acquired: Signed in 2024 (Mets)

Skinny: Part of the trade with New York for Cedric Mullins, the reliever joined the IronBirds and finished with a sub-2.00 ERA in nine appearances in August and September. Before the trade, he was with High-A Brooklyn, where he had a 3-1 record with 38 strikeouts and 16 walks in 31 1-3 innings over 25 games.



Twine Palmer (No. 13)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-5, 200
Born: 8/31/04

Hometown: McAlester, Okla.
How acquired: 19th-round pick in 2024 (Houston)

Skinny: He arrived as part of the Ramón Urías trade in 2025. He spent the first part of 2025 with Fayetteville, going 2-0 with a 2.13 ERA over 42 1-3 innings. After joining Delmarva in late July, he went 0-2 with a 9.15 ERA over five starts and 19 2-3 innings.



JT Quinn (No. 9)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-6, 214
Born: 4/22/04

Hometown: Tampa, Fla.
How acquired: Second-round pick in 2024

Skinny: The No. 19 rated Orioles prospect, he did not pitch for the organization in 2025 after being drafted. He is considered a power righty with a fastball that sits in the mid-90s, but needs development with his offspeed deliveries. Found success in college as a swingman after transferring to Georgia as a junior.



Brayden Smith (No. 23)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 6-0, 190
Born: 12/15/03

Hometown: Omaha, Neb.
How acquired: 13th-round pick in 2025

Skinny: After getting drafted in 2025, he joined Delmarva in mid-August, playing in 16 games and hitting .200 with one home run and nine RBIs. As a junior at Oklahoma State, he hit .313 with eight homers, 14 doubles, two triples and 28 RBIs.



Tanner Smith (No. 27)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-6, 245
Born: 8/5/02

Hometown: Duxbury, Mass.
How acquired: 15th-round pick in 2024 (San Diego)

Skinny: Part of the trade deadline deal with San Diego in 2025, the former Harvard University hurler spent the month of August in Delmarva before joining Aberdeen. Appeared in 25 games, finishing with a 6.00 ERA with the Shorebirds.



Ryan Stafford (No. 10)

Position: Catcher
Height, weight: 5-10, 180
Born: 1/15/03

Hometown: Folsom, Calif.
How acquired: Fifth-round pick in 2024

Skinny: Serving as Delmarva's primary catcher for much of the 2025 season, he hit .178 with 26 RBIs, 15 doubles and two triples while also swiping 22 bases over 96 games. Is still searching for his first professional home run. As a junior at Cal Poly in 2024, he hit .368 with an OBP of .444 over 57 games.



Braylin Tavera (No. 39)

Position: Outfielder
Height, weight: 6-3, 175
Born: 2/19/05

Hometown: Hato Mayor, D.R.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2022

Skinny: He played the entire 2025 season with Delmarva, hitting .226 with seven home runs, 44 RBIs and 18 stolen bases while also dealing with an injury that kept him out of action in the middle of the season. Also spent much of 2024 with the Shorebirds.



Colin Tuft (No. 2)

Position: Catcher
Height, weight: 6-3, 206
Born: 1/24/03

Hometown: Vienna, Va.
How acquired: Eighth-round pick in 2024

Skinny: Played a season-high 56 games with Delmarva last year as the backup catcher and hit .207 with one homer and 13 RBIs. Also was sent to rehab last May to the FCL Orioles.



Ben Vespi (No. 37)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-3, 190
Born: 5/28/01

Hometown: Boynton Beach, Fla.
How acquired: Signed as a free agent in 2024

Skinny: Started the year with Delmarva and pitched 22 games with a 3-2 record and 3.02 ERA. Finished with 50.2 innings with Delmarva as he moved throughout the farm system. Got called up to the IronBirds in July and pitched in eight games while serving as a late-game reliever, going 3-1.



Evan Yates (No. 48)

Position: Right-handed pitcher
Height, weight: 6-2, 180
Born: 9/17/02

Hometown: Redlands, Calif.
How acquired: 20th-round pick in 2024

Skinny: He spent much of 2025 with Delmarva, where he transitioned to starting. Recorded 87 strikeouts in 71 2-3 innings with a 4-6 record and 4.52 ERA with the Shorebirds. Got called up to Aberdeen and went 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA over 20 innings there as a reliever.



Colin Yeaman (No. 16)

Position: Infielder
Height, weight: 6-2, 200
Born: 4/15/04

Hometown: Saugus, Calif.
How acquired: Fourth-round pick in 2025

Skinny: After getting drafted, the Orioles' No. 28-ranked prospect played in 17 games for Delmarva last season as a late call-up, primarily playing third base. A disciplined hitter, he had a big year in 2025 with UC Irvine after hitting .336 with 13 homers, 56 RBIs and an OPS over 1.000.



Collin Woody (No. 21)

Position: Manager
Skinny: Woody spent the last two seasons in the Baltimore organization as Single-A Delmarva's manager, compiling a 104-157 record. He took over the Shorebirds in 2024 with no previous managerial experience. Previously served as the fundamentals coach for the Orioles' Florida Complex League team. He was last in Frederick nearly eight years ago. Woody ended his brief minor league career with the Keys, playing 79 games in 2018.
