



ALL-COUNTY SOFTBALL

Player of the Year TAYLOR SMITH

CATOCTIN, SENIOR, PITCHER

■ After missing all of last season with an ACL injury, Smith returned to have one of the best overall seasons in Frederick County softball history. She not only resumed her role as a drop ball-dealing ace who piled up strikeouts and rarely gave up earned runs, but she emerged as one of the most dangerous power hitters in the state. She led the Cougars to the Class 1A state championship game, where they fell 4-3 to Mardela, and was named the Gatorade Maryland State Player of the Year.

■ She was a strikeout machine who rarely gave up earned runs, surrendering just 7 in 117 2-3 innings for a county-best 0.42 ERA. Had 287 strikeouts for a strikeout per 7-inning average of 17.1—both those figures led the county.

■ While Smith was a decent hitter in the past, she emerged as one of the county's top power hitters. She had a county-best 15 homers—one shy of the state record—a county-best 40 RBIs and batted .430.

■ Will continue her career at the University of Virginia.



FIRST TEAM

SAMIYAH ABDUL-KHABIR SENIOR, OUTFIELD FREDERICK

■ A leadoff hitter who became the first FCPS player in recent memory to finish with a batting average over .700. Had a Frederick County-best .707 average with 4 HRs, 3 triples and 14 doubles. Will continue her career at Bowie State.



KATIE DEGIROLAMO SENIOR, INFIELD FREDERICK

■ Three-year captain who finished her stellar career as Frederick's top defensive player as well as a reliable hitter. Had a .900 fielding percentage as a shortstop, third baseman and pitcher. Batted .428 and ranked among the county's RBI leaders with 26.



IZZY DIETRICH SENIOR, PITCHER WALKERSVILLE

■ Reliable workhorse in the circle who pitched all but 15 innings for one of the county's top teams. Went 12-6 with a 2.18 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 106 innings pitched.



AVA FIELDS SOPHOMORE, OUTFIELD URBANA

■ Center fielder and co-captain for the CMC Large Schools champs. Threw out multiple runners at home plate and used her speed to track down balls. Batted .391 with 2 homers and a team-high 19 RBIs.



CAITLIN HINKELMAN SOPHOMORE, CATCHER WALKERSVILLE

■ Returning first-teamer filled vacant catcher role admirably. She caught every inning (124), called most of the pitches for fellow first-teamer Izzy Dietrich, only allowed 4 passed balls and controlled the running game. Batted .311 with 3 HRs, 4 doubles and 15 RBIs.



KASSIDY KREITZ JUNIOR, INFIELD CATOCTIN

■ Cleanup hitter for the hard-hitting Cougars, she did a solid job in the circle when ace Taylor Smith needed a break. Batted .384 with 7 homers, 6 doubles, 1 triple and 30 RBIs. Throwing 23 1-3 innings, had an 0.90 ERA and 45 strikeouts.



BRADYN MACKAY JUNIOR, INFIELD LINGANORE

■ Leadoff batter who ranked among Frederick County's top hitters, and she locked down the SS position for one of the county's best teams. Batted .523 and had 20 RBIs. A three-year starter and captain.



GABY MCANAW FRESHMAN, PITCHER URBANA

■ Newcomer emerged as one of Frederick County's top pitchers. Went 10-6, ranked third in the county in strikeouts with 204 and had a 1.42 ERA in 108 2-3 innings pitched. Tied for the team lead (with her sister) in homers with 5 and was second in RBIs with 16.



LO MCANAW JUNIOR, CATCHER URBANA

■ Co-captain who transitioned from SS to catcher to fill a critical void for the CMC Large Schools champion Hawks. Had a .991 fielding percentage at her new position. Hit .382 and tied her sister for the team lead in homers with 5. Had a team-high 10 stolen bases.



HAYDEN MOXLEY JUNIOR, PITCHER-INFIELD MIDDLETOWN

■ Rock-solid pitcher and good bat for a Middletown team that went 15-6 and won the CMC Gambrell title. Went 7-4 with a 1.45 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 86 2-3 innings pitched. Batted .328 with 2 HRs and 15 RBIs.



AVERY NEUMAN SENIOR, PITCHER TUSCARORA

■ An ace and feared hitter who led the Titans to their first winning season in 10 years and first regional crown in 19 years. Batted .532 with 4 HRs, 25 RBIs and a slew of intentional walks. The St. John's commit went 12-4 with an 0.53 ERA and 255 strikeouts in 106 innings.



MADISON OHLER SENIOR, OUTFIELD CATOCTIN

■ A center fielder with gap-to-gap power for the Class 1A state finalist Cougars. Batted .405 with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 28 RBIs.



HAILEY PUTNAM SENIOR, INFIELD WALKERSVILLE

■ The toughest bat in Walkersville's lineup and one of the toughest in Frederick County. Led the Lions in average (.492), homers (4), doubles (6) and RBIs (32).



LILLY TRUNNELL JUNIOR, CATCHER LINGANORE

■ A feared power hitter and standout catcher for one of Frederick County's top teams. Led the Lancers in batting average (.576) and RBIs (36). Had 13 doubles, 1 triple and 2 home runs. Kept baserunners honest and routinely snagged foul pops.



BRALYN WEST SOPHOMORE, OUTFIELD-INFIELD CATOCTIN

■ A gap-to-gap leadoff hitter with power and a sure glove in left field for a team that reached the 1A state final. Led the Cougars in batting average (.506) and ranked second in the county in HRs (8). Had 11 doubles, 4 triples, a 1.012 slugging percentage and 34 RBIs.
