Dear Attorney General Brown,

I am requesting your office to intervene and conduct the administrative investigation of the sexual assault that occurred at Brunswick High School during the 2024/2025 academic year. The criminal matter is being investigated by the Frederick County Sheriff's Office.

As far as the administrative investigation, I personally reached out and met with Dr. Cheryl Dyson, the FCPS Superintendent, as well as their Chief Legal Counsel Michael DuBey. During this meeting, I was informed that the investigation was ongoing, expressing problems interviewing the 10-month employees, while full-time staff at BHS state they have not been interviewed to date. This is unacceptable. This investigation should be the highest priority for FCPS, yet to date, no action has been taken with regard to the administrators' failure to follow policy and their lack of accountability in the matter. The community, students, faculty and staff deserve answers.

This urgency of my request is due to an overwhelming outcry from the community, a lack of transparency and accountability by administrators who failed to follow policies, allowing children unsupervised in the locker rooms, where the unfortunate assaults occurred.

At a community forum last Friday, there was a great deal of expressed concern and fear from parents who now have to send their children to Brunswick High School for the upcoming school year scheduled to begin August 20th. Your timely response to this request is greatly appreciated.
