The night of the incident at Westview, my buddy [REDACTED] and I were called out of our seats in order to give a written statement to the officers. I don't believe that I included one additional piece of information when I was interviewed at the Frederick County Sheriff's Department.

I noticed the victim lying on his side and one of the officers' using his foot to keep the victim on his side. This is generally a technique used by first responders to keep a victim from suffering from labored breathing.





He started to fight back and ended up on the floor at the exit ramp of the theater while the officers tried to calm him. I was standing down by the exit door with the helper and she was saying that he doesn't like being touched and that if they let go it would be fine. The struggle went on for a min or two when he was pulled and rolled over and one of the officers was checking his pulse and couldn't find one. At this point someone said he isn't breathing and the officers started taking the cuffs off of him and told me to get a CPR mask. I left for a min to the Concessions stand to get a breathing mask and when I came back they had the gentleman on his side breathing and didn't need it. I was told by them an ambulance was called and I left the theater to stop the crowd of movie goers from coming into the theater while he was still here. Paramedics showed up along with state police and once they were here I stepped back away from the situation and let them take care of everything.


