



ALL-COUNTY GIRLS LACROSSE

Offensive Player of the Year JULS BRAWNER

FREDERICK SENIOR MIDFIELD
■ A versatile athlete who once again reminded everyone her main sport is lacrosse. Concluded her stellar career, which included Co-Offensive Player of the Year honors last season, with another prolific season. She was responsible for 86 percent of Frederick's offense, and she leaves the program with school records for goals and points in a career.
■ Had a Frederick County-best 67 goals along with 18 assists. Her 85 points ranked third in the county, and the players above both played four more games.
■ Also ran cross-country and track and field and played basketball for the Cadets. Will continue her lacrosse career at Kennesaw State.



Defensive Player of the Year MADDY HARSHMAN

MIDDLETOWN JUNIOR GOALIE
■ Her dependability in goal was one of the main reasons the Knights shook off a slow start and put together a successful 13-5 season that saw them win the CMC Small Schools title and reach the Class 1A state championship game.
■ Ranked high on the Frederick County goalkeeping leaders list with a save percentage of .530 and a 6.94 goals against average.



FIRST TEAM

CORA BETTEN SENIOR MIDFIELD URBANA

■ Speedy standout who helped the Hawks win the CMC Large Schools title and reach the Class 4A state championship game, where they lost to Broadneck. Had 54 goals, 11 assists, 48 draw controls, 21 caused turnovers and 38 ground balls.



LILY BROWN JUNIOR ATTACK MIDDLETOWN

■ She and Kacie Phillips formed a lethal 1-2 punch on attack to help the Knights become the Class 1A state runner-up. Finished with a Frederick County-best 98 points (57 goals, 41 assists).



SEDONA BROWN SOPHOMORE ATTACK LINGANORE

■ Wasted little time establishing herself as a force after an injury derailed her freshman season. Ranked high among Frederick County's scoring leaders with 61 goals and 3 assists.



EMMA CAREY SENIOR MIDFIELD OAKDALE

■ Emerged as one of the county's top scoring threats during her first full year as a midfielder. Ranked on the county scoring leaders list with 47 goals and 26 assists. Also had 54 draw controls and 17 ground balls. Will play at George Mason.



HELAINA CULLUM SENIOR DEFENSE URBANA

■ Was the leader of Urbana's newly installed spider defense and a force in the draw circle who helped the Hawks go 16-3 and reach the 4A state championship game. Had 28 draw controls, 15 ground balls and 10 caused turnovers.



KAMRYN DAVIS SENIOR DEFENSE THOMAS JOHNSON

■ Three-year captain who made a huge impact for the rebuilding Patriots. Finished with 22 caused turnovers and 29 ground balls. Also chipped in offensively with 4 goals and 2 assists. Will play at Winthrop.



ALYSSA HARTIS SENIOR MIDFIELD TUSCARORA

■ Returning first-teamer who remained a threat, finishing with 45 goals, 17 assists and 45 draw controls. Also a standout flag football player. Will play lacrosse at Queens University.



JOSEY HINES JUNIOR ATTACK URBANA

■ With a nose for the goal and knack for setting up others, she was one of three huge offensive threats (the others are also first-teamers) for the 4A state runner-up. Had 46 goals, 26 assists, 16 ground balls and 6 caused turnovers.



AVA HOLLANDER SOPHOMORE ATTACK LINGANORE

■ Another young, productive player for one of Frederick County's top teams. Spent all season on Frederick County's scoring leaders list, finishing with 43 goals and 11 assists.



COLBY JOHNSON JUNIOR MIDFIELD URBANA

■ Equipped with a wicked shot, among other things, she was another major threat for the 4A state runner-up. Had a team-high 55 goals along with 13 assists, 46 draw controls, 24 ground balls and 10 caused turnovers.



ALAYNA KELLY SENIOR ATTACK CATOCTIN

■ Formed a potent duo with her twin sister, Lauren, to help lead the CMC Antietam champion Cougars. Had a Frederick County-best 51 assists along with 18 goals to rank high on the county scoring leaders list.



LAUREN KELLY SENIOR MIDFIELD CATOCTIN

■ Joined forces with twin sister Alayna to lead the offense for the CMC Antietam champion Cougars. A strong finisher who had a team-high 49 goals along with 10 assists, putting her among the county's scoring leaders.



KATHERINE MOORE SENIOR DEFENSE OAKDALE

■ Returning first-teamer who was the backbone of the defense of one of Frederick County's top teams. Had 15 caused turnovers and 14 ground balls. Also had 9 goals and 2 assists.



KACIE PHILLIPS SOPHOMORE ATTACK MIDDLETOWN

■ Returning first-teamer who formed a 1-2 punch with fellow attack Lily Brown to help the Knights reach the Class 1A state final. Ranked second in the county in points with 95 (56 goals, 39 assists). Had 104 draw controls, 35 ground balls and 13 caused turnovers.



AVERY RAY SOPHOMORE MIDFIELD OAKDALE

■ Relentless performer on both sides of the field and a force on draws for one of the county's top teams. Led the Bears in draw controls with 69. Also had 37 goals, 6 assists and 10 caused turnovers.



HADLEY ROBERTSON SENIOR ATTACK LINGANORE

■ Provided valuable senior leadership to a young team that remained one of the county's best. With an ability to score or distribute, she finished with 25 goals and 28 assists.



DELANEY STUP SENIOR MIDFIELD TUSCARORA

■ Returning first-teamer who was a handful for opposing defenses and a force on draws. Ranked high on the county scoring leaders list with 70 points (62 goals, 8 assists). Also had 94 draw controls. Will play at George Mason University.
