The Renew Atlanta/TSPLOST programs, launched in 2015 and 2016, were created to help address more than \$1 billion in infrastructure backlog facing the City. Though the programs have made much progress to date delivering key projects across Atlanta, we face significant challenges as we move forward to complete the full initial program scope. Moreover, the cost to deliver the full scope of the initial program considerably exceeds the funding available from the Renew Atlanta Bond and anticipated TSPLOST revenues.

Thus, we are working diligently to prioritize and re-baseline the initial program lists to deliver the greatest impact to Atlanta's above-ground infrastructure and transportation network with the available funds. Through this re-baselining effort, we are dedicated to engaging all stakeholders to help inform the process in a transparent and meaningful way. We greatly appreciate those that have participated in our first round of public engagement sessions and online surveys. Please attend and invite your family, friends, and neighbors to the final round of public engagement sessions, so that everyone's voice can be heard.
