Cathryn Ann Kearns passed away unexpectedly on February 23, 2018. Cathryn was born on October 5, 1979 in Honolulu, HI to Patrick and Jean Kearns, but moved to Peachtree City in 1994 and resided in Georgia since. She was an amazing educator for the past 15 years, earning degrees in Education from Georgia State University and Central Michigan. She started her teaching career at Adamson Middle School where she also coached the cheerleading squad. For the past 12 years, Cathryn was a beloved teacher at Sutton Middle School in Atlanta. She was the English Language Arts 6th grade content lead, taught various summer programs, and was involved in many other ways. She started the volleyball program at Sutton, and coached the team for the last eight years. She also coached intramural basketball, yoga, and 5k. In addition, she was an avid philanthropist. She and her students collected countless can pop tops to raise money for the Ronald McDonald House Charity, an organization that benefited her sister Carrie and her family. She also raised over \$20,000 for breast cancer awareness through many different fundraisers in memory of her mother Jean.

Cathryn is survived by her father Patrick Kearns, her brother Colin Kearns, her sister-in-law Drift Kearns, nieces Kiera and Keely Kearns, nephew Kason Kearns; and numerous extended family members who loved and cherished her dearly.
