### NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Proposals addressed to the City of Jamaica Beach, 5264 Jamaica Beach, Jamaica Beach, TX 77554 will be received at City Hall until **January 14, 2026 at 2:00 PM** and then publicly opened and read aloud at the same location and time for:

#### **"WWTP Electrical Improvements"**

Any bids received after the above-stated date and time will be returned unopened.

A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The project will consist of the following types of construction work:

1. Demo & fill of abandoned lift station wet well
2. Installation of an elevated generator platform
3. Installation of GENERATOR & ATS SUPPLIED BY CITY
4. Furnish & install new lightning arrestor
5. Furnish & install 550 gallon fuel tank & fuel line
6. Furnish & install 400 Amp 3 phase power panel
7. Furnish & install control panels, meters & power zone
8. Furnish & install conduit, fitting & supports
