Electronic qualifications packages, Galveston Harbor and Channel Section 216 Study, for the Port of Galveston, Galveston, Texas will be received electronically until **2:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 19th, 2026**, and then publicly opened and read aloud at the Port's Administrative offices located in the **Shearn Moody Plaza building at 123 25th St., 8th Floor, Galveston, TX 77550**.

The Board of Trustees of the Galveston Wharves, Galveston, Texas (the "Port"), acting as the non-Federal sponsor, hereby solicits Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from qualified Architect-Engineer (A-E) firms to provide professional planning, engineering, environmental, economic, and program management services necessary to complete a Section 216 Review of Completed Project Study for the Galveston Harbor and Channel Federal Navigation Project.

Questions shall be submitted electronically through the e-Procurement Portal by **2:00 p.m. (CST) on Friday, August 7th, 2026**.

Information concerning the criteria by which the qualifications will be evaluated, and a contract will be awarded are included in the qualifications package included therein.

Respondents may withdraw their submission, either personally or by written request, at any time prior to the scheduled time for the opening. The Galveston Wharves may hold the responses for 60 days (or such other timeframe required by law) after the date set for the opening without making a decision and the respondents may not withdraw their bid(s) within that time.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all of the responses, in whole or in part, and to accept the response or responses, in whole or in part, for any reason or to negotiate with any and all respondents and waive any informality in responses received.
