Dear Regents:

This afternoon I have placed Dr. Ben Raimer, president of The University of Texas Medical Branch, on administrative leave. Dr. Raimer is on leave pending an investigation into allegations of conduct that, if true, likely violates Regents Rules, UTS policy, and UTMB policy. I have worked with Office of General Counsel as well as outside counsel specializing in the particulars of this matter. I consulted with Chairman Eltife prior to meeting with Dr. Raimer. We will be making an announcement to the campus soon announcing that Dr. Charles Mouton, Executive Vice President and Provost and Dean of the School of Medicine, will serve as administrator-in-charge at this time. Since this is a personnel matter we will have no public comment on reasons for the administrative leave or the investigation. I will, of course, be prepared to answer any questions you may have, and I anticipate that I will brief the Board in executive session at our August meeting. Thank you.
