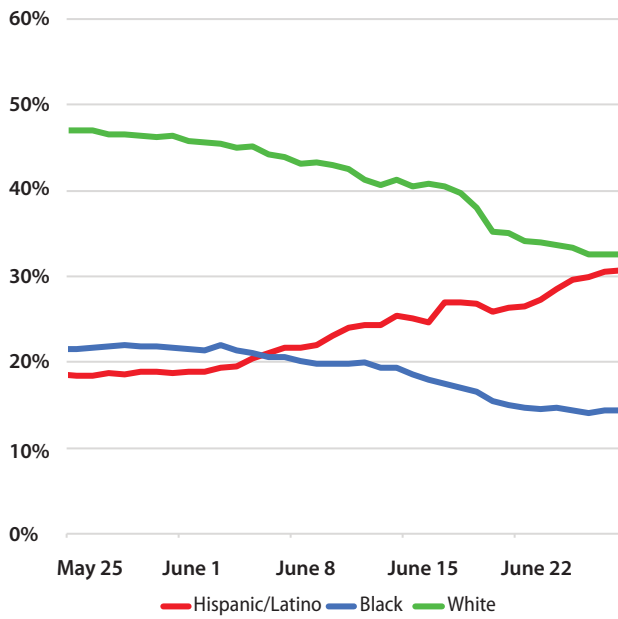


Growth in Hispanic Cases in Galveston County

During the last month, the percent of cases identified in Hispanic and Latino residents of Galveston County have increased more than in any other racial group. The number of Hispanic or Latino residents identified with COVID-19 has grown by 777 people since Memorial Day, a 535 percent increase. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, Hispanic people make up about 25 percent of Galveston County's population. As of Sunday, Hispanic people made up 31.5 percent of the county's COVID-19 cases.
