STORY LINES

GAME TIME

The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater football team hosts Mary Hardin-Baylor (Texas) for a semifinal game of the NCAA Division III Championship this Saturday at 2:30 p.m. at Perkins Stadium. The Warhawks are an automatic qualifier out of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, while the Crusaders are the automatic qualifiers out of the American Southwest Conference.

The Warhawks outscored eighth-ranked Central (Iowa) 24-0 in the second half to turn a 27-21 halftiem lead into a 51-21 victory last Saturday in a national quarterfinal at Perkins Stadium. UW-W held the Dutch, which entered the game as Division III's top passing attack, to 286 yards passing, more than 100 below their season average.

The Warhawks are No. 3 in the latest D3football.com Top 25, earning 580 points from pollsters without receiving a first-place vote. UW-W is also third in the latest American Football Coaches Association Division III Coaches' Poll, picking up 1,080 points and one first-place vote from panelists. The team was ranked second in the *Lindy's Sports* Preseason Division III Top 25 and fourth in the preseason by *College Football America*.

Mary Hardin-Baylor, ranked second in the nation by both D3football.com and the AFCA, scored 21 unanswered points during a 15-minute stretch in the first and second quarters to take a 21-3 advantage on its way to a 49-24 victory against No. 7 Linfield (Ore.). The Crusaders totaled 538 yards of offense, including 402 through the air, while the defense totaled five sacks. Kyle King threw for six touchdown passes in the contest.

SERIES

The Warhawks and Crusaders are meeting for the third straight season in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. UMHB posted a 31-14 victory in the semifinals on Dec. 8, 2018, in Belton, Texas, forcing four UW-Whitewater turnovers and getting 168 yards and two touchdowns from Markeith Miller. UW-W returned to Belton for the quarterfinals the next season, topping the Cru 26-7 on Dec. 7, 2019. The Warhawks rushed for 239 yards and held the ball for nearly 43 minutes of the game, and held Mary Hardin-Baylor to 140 yards of total offense, including minus-3 yards rushing.

WHAT'S NEXT

The winner of Saturday's game advances to Stagg Bowl XLVIII to play the winner of the North Central (Ill.) at Mount Union (Ohio) game on Friday, Dec. 17, at 6 p.m. CT in Canton, Ohio.

GAME NOTES

- **A Consistent Winner:** UW-Whitewater has reached the quarterfinals of the NCAA Division III Playoffs in 14 of the last 16 years, including 13 semifinal appearances over that span. The Warhawks currently own six national championships (2007, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2014), second-most in Division III history, and a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference-best 38 league titles, including 13 in the last 16 years. Since the start of the 2005 season, the Warhawks:

- Have a 207-17 overall record (.924 winning percentage)
- Are 106-6 in regular season WIAC play (.946 winning percentage)
- Own a 57-7 mark in the NCAA Division III Playoffs (.891 winning percentage)
- Are 44-4 in regular season non-conference games (.917 winning percentage)
- Have appeared in the D3football.com Top 25 & AFCA national polls in all but 12 weeks
- Have amassed six winning streaks of 13 games or more, including two streaks that rank among the top six all time in NCAA Division III history

In its NCAA Division III history, entering the 2021 season, UW-Whitewater owns the fourth-best all time winning percentage at .698 (615-260-21) and ranks 16th in all time wins (615) despite playing at least 10 seasons fewer than any other institution among the top 20 on the list. During the 2010-19 decade, the Warhawks finished second in the nation in winning percentage (.911) and third in wins (123) after finishing among the top 15 in both categories in the previous decade (2000-09).

- **Warhawks Return to NCAA Playoffs:** UW-Whitewater and Mary Hardin-Baylor are two of the 32 teams included in the 2021 NCAA Division III Championship. The field includes 27 automatic qualifiers (Pool A) and five at-large teams (Pool C).

UW-Whitewater is 58-10 all time in the NCAA Division III Playoffs, good for an .853 winning percentage, and 1-1 in its lone NAIA Playoffs appearance (1966). The record includes six national championship runs and 10 trips to the Stagg Bowl. The Warhawks are 15-4 (.789) under head coach Kevin Bullis in five trips to the NCAA Playoffs.

- **Warhawks at No. 2 in Final Regional Rankings:** The Warhawks are No. 2 in the final edition of the NCAA Region VI Rankings, which were released prior to the first round of the NCAA playoffs. Regional leaders include Delaware Valley (I), SUNY Cortland (II), Mary Hardin-Baylor (III), Mount Union (IV), North Central (V) and St. John's (VI). Coming in behind St. John's and the Warhawks in Region VI, are, in order, Linfield (Ore.), UW-La Crosse, Bethel (Minn.), Redlands (Calif.), Gustavus Adolphus (Minn.) and UW-River Falls. The NCAA Regional Rankings are used to help determine at-large (Pool C) qualifiers, hosting privileges and seeding for the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

- **Playoff Peete:** Senior running back Alex Peete has rushed 112 times for 880 yards (7.9 yards per carry) and 13 touchdowns in his last six games. He has established three career highs during the 2021 NCAA Playoffs, starting with his 209-yard, four-touchdown performance in the second round against DePauw (Ind.) on Nov. 27. His four touchdowns tied a single-game program record. Peete carried a career-high 32 times for 181 yards and three scores in last Saturday's win against Central (Iowa). For the season, he enters Saturday's game ranked No. 1 in NCAA Division III in rushing touchdowns (25), total touchdowns (28) and total points scored (168). Peete also ranks among the top 10 in the nation in points per game (12.9) and rushing yards (1,403).

GAME NOTES

- **Offensive Players of the Week - Central:** Senior QB **Max Meylor** threw for two touchdowns, rushed for one touchdown and caught one touchdown, and totaled 230 yards passing and 38 yards rushing for the contest. His 10-yard touchdown pass to Tyler Holte midway through the first quarter put the Warhawks on the board and completed a seven-play, 81-yard drive. Later in the first, he ran to the left on a keeper on third and goal and posted a 2-yard touchdown to bring UW-W to within 14-13. He gave the team the lead with a 36-yard touchdown pass to Holte at the 12:51 mark of the second quarter, and caught a 4-yard touchdown from Wisniewski on a trick play on the ensuing drive, making it 27-14 with 5:59 left in the period. Senior RB **Alex Peete** finished with a career-high 32 carries for 181 yards and three touchdowns. He scored all three touchdowns in the second half, including a 13-yard run with 4:56 left in the third quarter, a 10-yard run at the 8:54 mark of the fourth and a 29-yard run with 3:40 remaining. Peete ran for 137 yards in the second half to help UW-Whitewater hold the ball for more than 21 minutes and maintain the lead.
- **Defensive Players of the Week - Central:** Sophomore DL **Justin Allen** registered five tackles, including a career-high three sacks, and helped the Warhawks hold Central to 267 yards, including minus-19 on the ground. He tallied his first sack of the game to stall a Dutch drive early in the second quarter, and collected his second of the contest later in the quarter to force a third-and-17. Allen's third sack, which occurred late in the third quarter, forced a Central punt. His other two tackles were on running plays, including one stop that limited a run to one yard. Senior DB **Mark McGrath** finished with three tackles, one pass breakup and one interception, which he returned for 25 yards just past the midway point of the second quarter to give the Warhawks great field position and set up a touchdown to make the score 27-14. He also broke up a pass near the end of the first half.
- **Special Teams Player of the Week - Central:** Freshman DB **Tegan Christiansen** recorded three tackles on special teams, including one on punt coverage and two on kickoff coverage. His stop in punt coverage limited a return to six yards, and his two tackles on kick cover held returns to 14 yards and eight yards.
- **Home Sweet Home:** As it hosts its 10th game of the season this Saturday, UW-Whitewater looks to continue a tradition of excellence playing at home. In games played at Perkins Stadium since the start of the 2005 season, the Warhawks are 119-4, good for a .967 winning percentage. Conference opponents have won only two games inside Perkins Stadium during that span, both in 2012 (UW-Stevens Point and UW-Oshkosh). UW-Whitewater has lost only one game played in Whitewater over the last six years and has won 29 straight games at Perkins Stadium entering Saturday's game, tied for the third-longest home winning streak in program history.
- **Meylor Named Gagliardi Semifinalist:** QB **Max Meylor** was selected as one of 15 semifinalists for the 2021 Gagliardi Trophy, an award presented by Jostens and the J-Club of St. John's University (Minn.) to the most outstanding football player in NCAA Division III. He enters UW-Whitewater's semifinal contest with 2,950 passing yards, 35 touchdowns and two interceptions in 13 games. He ranks among the top 20 in NCAA Division III in passing efficiency (185.3), completion percentage (70.6), passing touchdowns and yards per pass attempt (9.31). Meylor was named WIAC Offensive Player of the Year and first team all-conference, and was a WIAC Offensive Player of the Week during the season. He is majoring in occupational safety and is active as a volunteer in Whitewater and in his hometown of Mt. Horeb, Wis. Finalists will be announced Dec. 9.

Head Coach Kevin Bullis



Kevin Bullis was named head football coach at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater on Jan. 30, 2015. He enters his seventh year as head coach in 2021.

The Warhawks are coming off their first Stagg Bowl appearance under Bullis and 10th bid as a program. UW-Whitewater finished as national runner-up and Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference champion during the 2019 season, posting a 13-2 record, including a 6-1 mark in conference play.

Under Bullis' leadership, the Warhawks have collected 81 All-WIAC honors, 37 All-West Region accolades and 36 All-American awards. He owns an impressive 57-9 record through five seasons at the helm, good for a .864 winning percentage, and is 32-3 against conference competition (.914).

Bullis led UW-Whitewater to the program's 36th WIAC championship in 2018 after finishing the regular season with a perfect 10-0 record. He was named WIAC George Chryst Coach of the Year for the second time in his career. The team reached the NCAA semifinal round for the 11th time in program history.

Bullis earned his first WIAC Coach of the Year honor in 2016 after leading the team to the conference championship and the NCAA quarterfinal round for the 11th time in the last 12 years.

In his first season at the helm, the Warhawks reached the semifinals in the NCAA Division III Playoffs for the 10th time in the last 11 years. UW-Whitewater finished with a 12-2 record, including a 6-1 mark in the WIAC.

In addition to their excellence on the field, the Warhawks are dedicated, engaged members of the community under Bullis' leadership. The team racked more than 1,000 hours of community service during the 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 academic years, working on initiatives with Special Olympics Wisconsin and Fairhaven Senior Community and securing donations for the Whitewater Food Pantry.

UW-Whitewater student-athletes have also been superb in the classroom under Bullis. In 2019, linebacker Matt Anderson was named Academic All-America of the Year by the College Sports Information Directors of America as well as the NCAA's Elite 90 Award. Anderson was joined on CoSIDA's Academic All-America first team by defensive back Jacob Frey and offensive lineman Matthew Saager. In 2020-21, Kyle Gannon and Ryan Wisniewski each garnered Academic All-America accolades.

Bullis is the 21st head coach in the history of UW-Whitewater football and the fourth in the last 60 years. He served as defensive run game coordinator and defensive line coach during the 2014 season. He replaced Lance Leipold, who became head coach at Division I Buffalo.

The Warhawks reached the Stagg Bowl, the NCAA Division III championship game, six times in Bullis' seven years as an assistant coach, winning five national championships. The team has also collected six Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference titles over that span.

Under Bullis' tutelage, UW-Whitewater led the WIAC and placed 17th in NCAA Division III in sacks per game (3.07) and rushing defense (99.5 yards per game allowed) in 2014. Defensive linemen Zach Franz and Mykaell Bratchett earned all-conference honors, and Franz later collected first team All-America accolades from D3football.com.

In addition to coaching the defensive line and coordinating the run defense, Bullis assisted on special teams, recruited prospective defensive linemen in Wisconsin and Illinois, instructed courses and was an academic advisor to a number of student-athletes at UW-Whitewater.

Prior to joining the Warhawks, Bullis served as defensive coordinator at UW-River Falls from 1995-2007, including four seasons as assistant head football coach. During his 13 seasons with the Falcons, Bullis headed the defensive staff, coordinated recruiting efforts in Minnesota and assisted on special teams.

Bullis' other roles included defensive coordinator at Gustavus Adolphus (Minn.) College (1993-95), linebackers coach at UW-River Falls (1990-93) and linebackers coach at the University of Minnesota Morris (1988-89).

Bullis earned his bachelor's degree in social science and secondary education from Minnesota Morris in 1989, and received his master's degree in history from UW-River Falls in 1992. He and his wife, Kathy, reside in Whitewater and have three children, Jack, Jojo and Emme.
