### HOW THEY GOT HERE

**UWW** | The Warhawks earned an automatic bid to the playoffs with a WIAC championship this season. UWW beat Greenville in the NCAA First Round before shutting out DePauw 45-0 in the Second Round. The Warhawks came from behind to earn a 51-21 win last week over Central to advance to the semifinals.

**UMHB** | The Cru went 9-0 in league play to win the American Southwest Conference title and the league's automatic bid to the playoffs. UMHB beat SAA champion Trinity University 13-3 in the first round and advanced to the quarterfinals after a 42-7 win over Birmingham-Southern in the second round. UMHB beat Linfield 49-24 in last week's quarterfinal matchup to advance to the semifinals.



# UMHB CRUSADERS

## COACH PETE FREDENBURG

Pete Fredenburg began his career in Texas as a coach at several high schools including Canyon High School, New Braunfels High School and Giddings High School. After starting the UMHB football program in 1998, it took Fredenburg just four seasons to take the Cru to the NCAA Division III playoffs and just five years for him to guide UMHB to an American Southwest Conference championship. In only the seventh season of UMHB football, Fredenburg had the Cru in the NCAA Division III National Championship game.

UMHB won the NCAA Division III National Championship with a 24-16 victory over Mount Union in Stagg Bowl XLVI in 2018 and set an ASC record for wins in a season after finishing 15-0. Fredenburg has compiled a 229-39 record in 24 seasons as the only head coach in the history of the UMHB football program and he currently ranks among the top five active Division III head coaches in career victories. The Cru were ASC Champions in 2021, 2020-21, 2019, 2018, 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, and ASC Tri-Champions in 2015 and 2003 after winning their first ASC Championship in 2002. The Cru also finished the 2004 and 2017 seasons ranked 2nd in the nation in all three of the major Division III National Polls and finished at #1 in the country in every major poll following the 2016 and 2018 campaigns. Coach Fredenburg has coached 24 AFCA All-Americans, seven Academic All-Americans, 139 All-Region selections, 427 All-Conference players, 18 Academic All-District VI players and 231 Academic All-Conference selections during his tenure at UMHB. The Cru has also earned 16 trips to the NCAA Division III Football Championships under Coach Fredenburg, claiming berths in 2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2018 and 2019. Fredenburg is a 10-time ASC Coach of the Year and has also earned AFCA Regional Coach of the Year honors ten times in his career. He was named Liberty Mutual Division III Coach of the Year and also claimed American Football Monthly Division III Coach of the Year honors (2013) and AFCA Division III National Coach of the Year honors (2016). Fredenburg was elected to the Texas Sports Hall of Fame in the fall of 2017 and was officially inducted in April of 2018.

He had a thirteen-year tenure at Baylor University as Defensive Coordinator and assistant head coach. After the job at Baylor, he then moved to Louisiana State University. After one year at LSU, he was given the opportunity to be the Defensive Coordinator at Louisiana Tech University.

## PLAYERS TO WATCH

**QB Kyle King** | King returned to action last week, leading a UMHB offense that scored 49 points on the Wildcats. King set a new school record for six touchdown passes in a contest, going 24-for-32 for 345 yards in the air.

**LB Jacob Mueller** | Mueller led UMHB with 10 tackles last week, including big stops on special teams. He had five solo tackles with one quarterback hurry.

## LAST TIME OUT

UMHB took command last week against Linfield, cruising to a 49-24 win over Linfield. King threw a school-record six touchdown passes in the contest while receiver K.J. Miller matched his school-record 12 catches in the contest. UMHB's defense allowed 442 yards passing but held when it mattered, allowing the Wildcats their lowest point total of the season.

# UWW WARHAWKS

## COACH KEVIN BULLIS

Kevin Bullis was named head football coach at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater on Jan. 30, 2015. The Warhawks are coming off their first Stagg Bowl appearance under Bullis and 10th bid as a program. UW-Whitewater finished as national runner-up and Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference champion during the 2019 season, posting a 13-2 record, including a 6-1 mark in conference play.

Under Bullis' leadership, the Warhawks have collected 81 All-WIAC honors, 37 All-West Region accolades and 36 All-American awards. He owns an impressive 57-9 record through five seasons at the helm, good for a .864 winning percentage, and is 32-3 against conference competition (.914).

Bullis led UW-Whitewater to the program's 36th WIAC championship in 2018 after finishing the regular season with a perfect 10-0 record. He was named WIAC George Chryst Coach of the Year for the second time in his career. The team reached the NCAA semifinal round for the 11th time in program history.

In addition to their excellence on the field, the Warhawks are dedicated, engaged members of the community under Bullis' leadership. The team racked more than 1,000 hours of community service during the 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 academic years, working on initiatives with Special Olympics Wisconsin and Fairhaven Senior Community and securing donations for the Whitewater Food Pantry.

Bullis is the 21st head coach in the history of UW-Whitewater football and the fourth in the last 60 years. He served as defensive run game coordinator and defensive line coach during the 2014 season. He replaced Lance Leipold, who became head coach at Division I Buffalo.

The Warhawks reached the Stagg Bowl, the NCAA Division III championship game, six times in Bullis' seven years as an assistant coach, winning five national championships. The team has also collected six Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference titles over that span.

In addition to coaching the defensive line and coordinating the run defense, Bullis assisted on special teams, recruited prospective defensive linemen in Wisconsin and Illinois, instructed courses and was an academic advisor to a number of student-athletes at UW-Whitewater.

Prior to joining the Warhawks, Bullis served as defensive coordinator at UW-River Falls from 1995-2007, including four seasons as assistant head football coach. Bullis' other roles included defensive coordinator at Gustavus Adolphus (Minn.) College (1993-95), linebackers coach at UW-River Falls (1990-93) and linebackers coach at the University of Minnesota Morris (1988-89).

Bullis earned his bachelor's degree in social science and secondary education from Minnesota Morris in 1989, and received his master's degree in history from UW-River Falls in 1992. He and his wife, Kathy, reside in Whitewater and have three children, Jack, Jojo and Emme.

## PLAYERS TO WATCH

**QB Max Meylor** | Meylor was named WIAC Offensive Player of the Year this season. He is averaging 226.92 yards passing this season with 216 completions on 306 attempts. Meylor has added 233 yards on the ground and also has 159 yards punting for the Warhawks.

**DL Mackenzie Balanganayi** | Balanganayi earned WIAC Defensive Player of the Year honors this season. He is a force on the Warhawks frontline of defense with 11 quarterback hurries this season. Balanganayi also has eight tackles for loss and six sacks on the season.

## LAST TIME OUT

UW-Whitewater earned a 30-point win in their quarterfinal matchup against Central (Iowa) to advance to the NCAA Semifinals. The Warhawks trailed early but scored 24 unanswered points in the second half to put the game away.

## NOTABLES

**Shared History** | This is the fifth postseason meeting between the Warhawks and the Cru. UWW beat the Cru in the NCAA Quarterfinals in 2019 to end the Cru's last run at a national championship. The win was a bit of redemption for the Warhawks as UMHB ended their season in 2018 in the semifinal round.

**Under Bullis** | UMHB is 1-1 against UWW in the Bullis era. The Cru took a four-year hiatus from matchups with the Warhawks from 2014-2017. Bullis took over for the Warhawks in 2015, meeting the Cru for the first time during the 2018 season.

**Gagliardi Semifinalists** | This matchup features a pair of 2021 Gagliardi Trophy Semifinalists. UW-Whitewater quarterback Max Meylor is one of 12 quarterbacks in the semifinal pool while UMHB defensive back Jefferson Fritz is the lone defensive player on the ballot this season.

**New Records** | QB Kyle King set a new record for touchdown passes in a game last week with six TD throws. WR Brandon Jordan tied the UMHB record for touchdown receptions in a contest with three. WR K.J. Miller also tied his record for receptions in a contest with 12 last week.


