Mesa County could lose its variance if COVID-19 cases exceed a 15% positive rate in a two-week period – approximately 153 positive tests. There is an additional provision for no more than 50 hospitalizations over two weeks.

Mesa County's current public health order: all facilities and establishments are allowed to operate at up to 50% capacity, and not to exceed 175 people in indoor spaces, with physical distancing measures in place, including bars and nightclubs.
