



GRAND JUNCTION REGIONAL AIRPORT

Enplanements at Grand Junction Regional Airport

The number of enplanements at Grand Junction Regional Airport soared 12.63% from 2018 to 2019, as the airport ranked 179th in the United States for total enplanements.

Airlines, planes, destinations at Grand Junction Regional Airport

FRONTIER AIRLINES*: **Planes:** Primarily Airbus 320s with 186 seats **Destinations:** (Denver) 3X weekly

AVELO AIRLINES:** **Planes:** Boeing 737-800s with 189 seats **Destinations:** (Burbank, Calif.) 4X weekly

ALLEGIANT AIRLINES: **Planes:** Primarily Airbus 319s with 156 seats 2X weekly for each

Destinations: (Las Vegas); (Santa Ana/Orange County, Calif.); (Mesa, Ariz.) – seasonal, stops mid-April, resumes early October

UNITED AIRLINES: **Planes:** Primarily 50-76 seat regional jets (e.g. CRJs, E175s)

Destinations: (Denver) 3-6X daily; (Chicago O'Hare) 2X weekly

AMERICAN AIRLINES: **Planes:** Primarily 60-76 seat jets (e.g. CRJs, E175s) **Destinations:** (Dallas) 4X daily; (Phoenix) 3X daily,

DELTA AIRLINES: **Planes:** Primarily CRJ 200s with 50 seats **Destinations:** (Salt Lake City) 4X daily
