NARRATIVE

On 10/09/16 at approximately 0236 hours I was working Gonzaga Neighborhood patrol when GU security dispatched me to 100 E Sharp Ave. on a report of a running vehicle with the driver slumped over the wheel.

I arrived on scene and observed a silver Mercedes Benz [REDACTED] parked on the south side of E Sharp Ave. on the 100 block. I observed the vehicle to be running and an adult male driver/sole occupant of the vehicle inside. I could see the driver's head slumped to the side and his cell phone sitting in his hand in his lap.

The driver was finally roused by our flashlights and me tapping on the driver's door window. It was apparent when he awoke that he recognized the flashlights around the car meant that the police were there, and he spent approximately 20 seconds contemplating what to do.

The driver then attempted to put the vehicle in gear as if to drive away, at which time I opened the driver's door and instructed the driver to put it in park and shut the vehicle off, which he did.

I could immediately smell the odor of alcoholic beverages emitting from within the vehicle. I observed the driver's eyes to both be glassy and extremely bloodshot. The driver stated to me that he had consumed alcoholic beverages this evening, but did not specify how many. He told me that he had stopped drinking a while ago and that he was just coming back from dropping some friends off. He would not specify where the friends were that he dropped off. Based on my training and experience, I felt that the driver may be under the influence of alcoholic beverages while in physical control of a running motor vehicle in the state of Washington.

During my interaction with the driver, he asked multiple times if I could please let him go and let him just go up to his room and go to sleep.

I asked the driver if he would be willing to perform some voluntary field sobriety tests to determine his level of impairment, to which he stated "yeah, please".

Gonzaga University security was able to identify the driver as being a student/the defendant, Josh Perkins.

At this time WSP Trooper Curtis J. Cook arrived on scene and I advised him of the driver's desire to perform voluntary field sobriety tests.

The driver was ultimately arrested for DUI and I completed the DUI impound form. I
