

COVID-19 at some N.C. colleges and universities

There is no standard for what information and when colleges and universities publicly report about COVID-19 cases on their campuses. Some schools report cases only for residential students or students who have been on campus during the past 14 days, while others report all cases. Some break down case numbers by student or employee, while others do not. Some report cases daily, while others report weekly or periodically. Students may be tested on- or off-campus and may or may not report results to the school, though county health officials may report positive tests to schools when linked. This chart shows the data reported on the schools' websites as of 5 p.m. Friday.
