## **EARLY VOTING IN GUILFORD COUNTY**

The Guilford County Board of Elections has two competing plans for early voting, an official proposal approved by the Democratic majority and an alternate suggested by the 5-person board's two Republican members.

The majority plan would offer 17 days of early voting at 25 sites Oct. 15-31.


The alternate plan suggests 15 days with no Sunday voting. It would provide 19 early voting sites,

six fewer than the majority plan.


In the majority plan, polls would be open weekdays, 8 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Weekend voting would conclude at 5 p.m., except for the last day — Saturday, Oct. 31 — when polls would close at 3 p.m.

The minority plan proposes the same early voting hours, except for two Saturdays – Oct. 17 and 24 – when the sites would stay open until 6 p.m.
