









The SDR of cases has been consistently been less than 100 cases per day during the past several weeks, and has recently gone below 80 case per day in the past week.




Note travelers tests in blue with “local tests” in grey.


The overall positivity rate (5%) continues to be lower than the local positivity rate (10% in the past week).



The island-wide, daily COVID-19 hospitalized count has remains above the surge indicator of 20 per day, while the ICU count has not gone above the surge threshold of 5 per day. Deaths continue to be sporadic.



By age, all adult groups are decreasing and converging. There was a recent uptick in children, likely due to the start of school, but this has gone down within the past week and there is another uptick in elderly.



Most cases continue to be asymptomatic.
