Hafa Adai Senator Ridgell,

This is to request your support and urgent action on Bill 213. The legislation is needed in order to provide reliability and cost savings to our ratepayers.

I have to make a decision on whether project will continue or be scrapped by March 31st. It will be an unfortunate situation to have to scrap the project after all the planning and approvals it has received in the best interest of the ratepayers. Furthermore, the 41 MW Cabras plant would provide substantial benefits to the grid while introducing more renewables because of its size flexibility, quick starting and excellent capability to work with renewables. Achievement of the renewables mandate which you have championed would be significantly facilitated by the Cabras Machines.

The price of the Cabras 41 MW project will be increased after March 31st.. Although it could be still beneficial to ratepayers, the additional cost reduces savings to ratepayers. The price increase will be needed because of expiration of quotes mainly on the engines to be purchased. As we all know, inflation is on the rise and the world is experiencing supply difficulties on almost all material and parts needs. We have managed to keep the contract cost as is up to this time despite the project being a loss to KEPCO due to high relocation cost and inflationary increase on project cost. The magnitude of the increase would determine the viability of continuing the Cabras project which of course in any case would still require legislative approval to proceed.

It is my understanding that a committee report has not been issued to date on the bill. That most likely means the bill can't be addressed at next week's legislative session. I appeal to you to please assist us in moving a decision on Bill 213 forward. It is my understanding the Governor would sign the bill once received.
