Dear Neighbor,

As Mayor of Lawrenceville, I am writing to share information about a proposed annexation that includes your neighborhood and to invite you to learn more through upcoming public information meetings.

This proposal would bring residents in areas that already identify as Lawrenceville into the City limits, creating clear boundaries and expanding police and code enforcement coverage, while keeping the tax millage rate the same as Gwinnett County. There is no tax millage rate increase associated with this proposal.

Residents in the proposed area will have the opportunity to vote during the May 19, 2026, State and County Primary Election at their normal county polling location.

To help you learn more, the City of Lawrenceville will host several public information meetings where you can hear directly from City staff, ask questions, and learn how annexation may affect you.

All meetings begin at 6:00 pm and will be held in the City Council Chambers on the 4th floor of City Hall, 70 S. Clayton Street, Lawrenceville.
