Kevin Andrews Jr.

Kevin Andrews Jr., 36, is accused of shooting two Gwinnett police officers and killing one of them. Andrews has been accused of more than 100 criminal offenses in the past 20 years, including at least 27 felonies, 37 misdemeanors, failure to appear at least 20 times, contempt of court at least 10 times, and violating his probation at least 10 times. Andrews has been granted bond at least 18 times. Until his arrest in Gwinnett, he had spent roughly 3.5 years in county jails. There is no record of him having ever been in state or federal prison. Records in some cases were unavailable. — *Compiled by Nate McCullough*
