Doug Clark, Maintenance Supervisor, has spoken with the company that went on the roof to see what was causing the outage. It was reported that the unit was leaking what seemed to be oil. The units are no longer under warranty so prices are being collected to see what the cost will be to replace. Mr. Bell stated that the cost is going to be upward of \$30,000 plus. The reason for the cost is greatly due to the need for a crane that will need to be rented to hoist the units to the roof. Mr.Eddie Ray Bryan asked what is the time frame for repairing the intercom system at Fort Necessity School? It was damaged when lightning hit the school building during a severe thunderstorm. Mr. Bell let Mr. Bryan know that the system has been placed on BidSync and it will be two to three weeks before the bid ends. Mr. Eubanks asked when Baskin School will have cameras installed? He knows that other schools in the district have their cameras installed. Mr. Bell answered that he believes the cameras are being installed at this time. With no other business to discuss, Mrs. Nichols adjourned

Mr. Tim Eubanks called the Finance Committee Meeting to order. Mr. Eubanks mentioned that he has noticed that fuel prices have decreased in the past month. Mrs. Boquet stated that utilities and fuel are still high and at this rate it will be hard to sustain with the decrease in the student body. She also indicated that insurance will increase in January. Mrs. Alaina Nichols stated that it seems when teachers and staff get an increase in pay, insurance is sure to follow.

Mrs. Boquet informed the board that the business office is working on multiple audits at this time and is working on the finance report showing the deficit at the end of the year. She also stated that when the indirect cost from the ESSER funds ends and decisions that will need to be made. She feels that once ESSER ends the state will audit those funds. So at this point she is making sure that all the I's are dotted and the T's have been crossed. Mr. Danny Davis will we be short on money when those funds end? Mr. Bell said we will need to make some changes when that happens. Mrs. Nichols stated that other districts have come up with ways to make things work, surely we will be able to do the same. Mr. Bell stated that last year approximately 156 students left the school system to enter homeschool. He feels that when those students return to the school system, they will have to be caught up. Although there are teachers that have left school districts and are now teaching homeschool students, some are not

Mr. Davis asked how the cuts in the budget will affect academic goals? Mr. Bell said that the district has been working diligently the past few years to create a better curriculum. These funds accumulate through the year then we allocate them to the general functions. This month's interest and principal on our debt, we will be through with that in 2026. Mrs. Nichols asked how many retiree/rehires that are employed at this time? Mrs. Latanga Blackson said there are about 6-7 teachers that fall in that category. She also mentioned that she is required to run in the local paper every

month by law an ad that falls under critical shortage. This is required until they are filled with a teacher that is not
