**REPORT:**

ON SUNDAY 6-17-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 2:15 A.M., I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM THE RICHLAND PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE REQUESTING AN INVESTIGATOR TO GO TO 798 LAKE IRWIN DR. NORTH OF START. ONCE I WAS 10-8 ENROUTE, DY. JERRY SPENCER JR. TOLD ME BY RADIO THAT HE NEEDED ME ON HWY. 595 APPROXIMATELY 1 MILE SOUTH OF THE MOREHOUSE/RICHLAND PARISH LINE. UPON ARRIVING AT THE SCENE AT APPROXIMATELY 2:20 A.M. DY. SPENCER TOLD ME THAT THERE HAD BEEN AN ARGUMENT BETWEEN A MICHELLE AND RANDY OGDEN AND RANDY HAD BEEN TRANSPORTED TO THE RICHLAND MEDICAL CENTER BY MED LIFE AMBULANCE. DY. SPENCER TOLD ME THAT MICHELLE OGDEN TOLD HIM THAT SHE AND RANDY WERE PARKED IN A DRIVE OFF OF HWY 595, SHE IN HER VEHICLE, A 2003 TOYOTA SEQ. WHITE IN COLOR AND RANDY IN HIS VEHICLE, A 2006 FORD P/U BLACK IN COLOR. DY. SPENCER RELATED THAT MICHELLE SAID THAT SHE LEFT AND WAS DRIVING BACK TO THEIR HOUSE AT 798 LAKE IRWIN DR, OAK RIDGE, WHEN RANDY DROVE UP BEHIND HER AND RAMMED HER VEHICLE IN THE REAR. MICHELLE TOLD DY. SPENCER THAT SHE STOPPED HER VEHICLE AND RANDY GOT OUT OF HIS TRUCK AND RAN UP TO HER VEHICLE AND JUMPED ON THE RUNNING BOARD ON THE DRIVERS SIDE AND TRIED TO HIT HER. MICHELLE FURTHER RELATED TO

DY. SPENCER THAT SHE TOOK OFF AND RANDY WAS HOLDING ON TO HER VEHICLE AND THEN SHE STOPPED ABRUPTLY AND RANDY FELL OFF THE VEHICLE AND HIT HIS HEAD ON THE ASPHALT ROAD CAUSING INJURY TO HIS HEAD.

I MADE CONTACT WITH MICHELLE OGDEN AT THE SCENE AND SMELLED WHAT APPEARED TO BE ALCOHOL ON HER BREATH BUT NOTICED NO IMPAIRMENT IN HER SPEECH OR MOVEMENT. I ADVISED HER TO STAY THERE AND I WOULD TALK TO HER SHORTLY. I NOTICED DAMAGE TO THE REAR OF HER VEHICLE AND TOOK PHOTOS OF THE DAMAGE. I THEN NOTICED THE MIRROR ON THE DRIVERS SIDE OF THE VEHICLE WAS TWISTED TOWARD THE FRONT AND SMUDGE MARKS ON THE DRIVERS SIDE FRONT DOOR AND PHOTOGRAPHED THEM. I ASKED DY. SPENCER WHERE THE OTHER VEHICLE WAS AND HE TOLD ME THAT A SUBJECT HAD TAKEN THE VEHICLE TO THE HOSPITAL TO CHECK ON RANDY OGDEN AND HE WAS NOT AWARE AT THE TIME THAT THIS WAS THE OTHER VEHICLE INVOLVED, BUT THAT SGT. TOMMY ALEXANDER OF THE RAYVILLE POLICE DEPT. HAD CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE AT RICHARDSON CENTER MEDICAL CENTER. I FOUND OUT LATER THAT THE SUBJECT WAS NOEL ROBERTSON AND HE HAD BEEN TAKEN INTO CUSTODY BY SGT. ALEXANDER ON RAYVILLE POLICE DEPT. CHARGES.

I MADE CONTACT WITH MICHELLE OGDEN AGAIN AND ASKED HER WHAT HAPPENED. SHE TOLD ME THAT SHE AND RANDY HAD GOTTEN INTO AN ARGUMENT AND RANDY HAD RAMMED HER VEHICLE IN THE REAR. SHE SAID SHE STOPPED AND RANDY RAN UP TO HER VEHICLE AND JUMPED ON THE RUNNING BOARD AND TRIED TO HIT HER. SHE SAID SHE ACCELERATED FOR A MOMENT AND THEN MASHED HER BRAKES AND RANDY FELL ON THE PAVEMENT. MICHELLE'S BROTHER, GREGG LEE, AND HIS FRIEND MARTIN GILL SHOWED UP AT THE SCENE AND I TOLD GREGG TO BRING MICHELLE TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND WAIT FOR ME. I LEFT THE SCENE AND WENT TO THE RICHLAND MEDICAL CENTER TO CHECK ON RANDY. AT APPROXIMATELY 3:00 A.M., I ARRIVED AT THE RICHARDSON MEDICAL CENTER AND WENT INSIDE TO CHECK ON RANDY OGDEN. I WAS UNABLE TO TALK TO RANDY BECAUSE THE DOCTOR AND STAFF WERE BUSY TRYING TO GET HIM STABLE. I RETURNED OUTSIDE AND TOOK PICTURES OF RANDY'S TRUCK AND THE DAMAGE TO THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE, AND SECURED THE VEHICLE WITH DY. TRAVIS STEPHENSON. AT APPROXIMATELY 3:30 A.M., I WENT TO THE INVESTIGATOR'S OFFICE AND MET WITH MICHELLE OGDEN TO TAKE A RECORDED STATEMENT. I ADVISED MICHELLE OF HER MIRANDA RIGHTS AND SHE SIGNED THE FORM WAIVING HER RIGHTS AND AGREED TO TALK TO ME. NO CHARGES FILED AT THIS TIME. (SEE TRANSCRIBED STATEMENT)



AT APPROXIMATLEY 4:00 A.M., I RETURNED TO THE RICHLAND MEDICAL CENTER TO CHECK ON RANDY OGDEN, BUT WAS STILL UNABLE TO TALK TO RANDY. AT APPROXIMATLEY 4:15 A.M. RANDY'S PARENTS, GENE AND MARGIE OGDEN ARRIVED AT THE HOSPITAL. I TOLD THEM WHAT WAS GOING ON AND ESCORTED THEM TO THE WAITING ROOM. BOTH PARENTS HAD SEVERAL QUESTIONS FOR ME AND I TOLD THEM THAT I WOULD TRY TO ANSWER THEIR QUESTIONS AS SOON AS COULD AND WOULD BE INVESTIGATING WHAT HAD TRANSPIRED. the incident.

AT APPROXIMATLEY 6:00 A.M. RANDY OGDEN WAS AIR LIFTED FROM THE RICHARDSON MEDICAL CENTER TO L.S.U. SHREVEPORT.

AT APPROXIMATLEY 6:20 A.M. DY. JERRY SPENCER JR. DROVE RANDY'S TRUCK TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE. I SECURED THE VEHICLE AND KEPT THE KEYS.

AT APPROXIMATLEY 7:10 P.M. ON 6-17-07 I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM OLIVIA JONES OF THE L.S.U. MEDICAL CENTER IN SHREVEPORT ADVISING ME THAT RANDY OGDEN WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD BY DR. COUTHURST SIMPKINS AT 4:51 P.M. I TOLD MS. JONES THAT I NEEDED AN AUTOPSY AND WOULD GET DR. DAVID THOMPSON TO CALL HER. I MADE CONTACT WITH DR. THOMPSON AND HE SAID HE WOULD TAKE CARE OF ORDERING THE AUTOPSY.

ON 06-18-07 I HAD BEN MOONEY OF BEN'S WRECKER SERVICE TOW MICHELLE OGDEN'S WHITE TOYOTA SEQ. BEARING LA. LIC/ MRKC TO HIS SHOP ON ROSA ST. ONCE HE HAD THE VEHICLE LIFTED AND ON RACKS I CONDUCTED AN INSPECTION OF THE UNDERCARRIAGE AND FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ANYTHING BEING DRAGGED BY THE VEHICLE.

ON 6-19-07 AT APPROXIMATLEY 2:20 P.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM NOEL ROBERTSON OF 870 LAKE IRWIN RD., OAK RIDGE LA. MR. ROBERTSON TOLD ME THAT HE WAS AT THE RESIDENCE OF RANDY AND MICHELLE OGDEN ON THE MORNING THIS HAPPENED. HE SAID THAT HE, MICHELLE AND RANDY WERE AT 798 LAKE IRWIN RD. SITTING OUTSIDE AROUND A FIRE, WHEN RANDY GOT UP AND WALKED AWAY. MR. ROBERTSON SAID THAT THE NEXT THING HE SAW WAS RANDY LEAVING IN HIS TRUCK. HE SAID HE ASKED MICHELLE WHERE RANDY WAS GOING AND SHE SAID SHE DID NOT KNOW. HE TOLD MICHELLE TO CALL HIM BUT RANDY HAD LEFT HIS CELL PHONE. NOEL SAID THAT MICHELLE LEFT IN HER VEHICLE AND FOLLOWED RANDY SOUTH ON HWY 595 INTO RICHLAND PARISH AND HE LOST SIGHT OF THE VEHICLES. HE SAID A SHORT WHILE LATER HE RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM MICHELLE TELLING HIM TO COME HELP HER THAT THERE HAD BEEN AN ACCIDENT. NOEL SAID HE DID NOT HAVE A

VEHICLE SO HE RODE RANDY'S RANCHER ATV APPROXIMATELY 1 MILE SOUTH ON HWY. 595 IN RICHLAND PARISH. NOEL SAID THAT WHEN HE ARRIVED ON THE SCENE, RANDY WAS LAYING ON THE BLACKTOP ON HIS BACK AND IT SOUNDED LIKE HE WAS SNORING. HE SAID HE KNELT DOWN AND HELD RANDY'S HEAD IN HIS HAND AND SAW BLOOD ON HIS HAND. HE SAID HE CALLED 911 AND STAYED THERE UNTIL THE AMBULANCE ARRIVED. ONCE THE AMBULANCE LEFT GOING TO RICHARDSON MEDICAL CENTER, HE SAID HE TOOK RANDY'S TRUCK AND WENT TO THE HOSPITAL. (SEE TRANSCRIBED STATEMENT FOR FULL REPORT)

ON 6-21-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 9:45 A.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM DAVID TEMPLETON. MR. TEMPLETON TOLD ME THAT HE WAS AT RANDY AND MICHELLE'S HOUSE WITH HIS WIFE, WANDENE, AND THEIR KIDS ON THE NIGHT OF 6-16-07 BUT LEFT AT APPROXIMATELY 10:30 P.M. AND DID NOT KNOW WHAT HAD HAPPENED UNTIL THE NEXT DAY. (SEE TRANSCRIPT FOR MORE INFORMATION)

ON 06-28-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 11:30 A.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM CLOIS KING. MR. KING CAME TO MY OFFICE AT MY REQUEST BECAUSE OF INFORMATION HE HAD GIVEN ME ON THE PHONE A FEW DAYS PRIOR. MR. KING TOLD ME IN HIS STATEMENT THAT HE HAD OVER HEARD MICHELLE OGDEN, GILL, AND A MAN REFERRED TO AS 'BUBBA', PLOTTING TO KILL SOMEONE. HE SAID THAT THIS HAPPENED AT THE DELHI FEED STORE IN DELHI, LA. MR. KING SAID THAT HE HEARD THIS APPROXIMATELY 3 WEEKS PRIOR TO RANDY OGDEN'S DEATH. SEE TRANSCRIBED STATEMENT FOR MORE INFORMATION)

ON 07-02-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 9:00 A.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM JUANDINE TEMPLETON. MRS. TEMPLETON SAID THAT SHE AND HER HUSBAND DAVID WERE AT RANDY AND MICHELLE OGDEN'S HOUSE FROM JUST BEFORE DARK UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 10:30 P.M. ON THE DAY IN QUESTION AND KNEW NOTHING OF THE ACCIDENT UNTIL THE NEXT MORNING. (SEE TRANSCRIBED STATEMENT FOR MORE INFORMATION)

ON 07-05-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 10:45 A.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM GREGORY G. LEE. I ASKED MR. LEE WHAT HE KNEW ABOUT WHAT HAD HAPPENED BETWEEN HIS SISTER MICHELLE OGDEN AND RANDY OGDEN. MR. LEE TOLD ME THAT HE RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM MARTIN GILL AT APPROXIMATELY 2:00 A.M. ON 06-17-07 AND TOLD HIM THAT MICHELLE HAD CALLED HIM AND TOLD MARTIN THAT THERE HAD BEEN AN ACCIDENT. MR. LEE SAID ABOUT 30 SECONDS LATER, MICHELLE CALLED HIM AND HE TOLD HER THAT HE WAS ON THE WAY TO HER. (SEE

**ON 07-05-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 1:25 P.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM JAMES MARTIN GILL. MR. GILL TOLD ME THAT HE RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM MICHELLE OGDEN AND SHE TOLD HIM THAT THERE HAD BEEN AN ACCIDENT AND THE AMBULANCE WAS ON THE WAY TO GET THEM. MR. GILL SAID HE THEN CALLED HER BROTHER, GREG LEE AND TOLD HIM WHAT WAS SAID. GILL SAID THAT HE WENT AND PICKED MR. LEE UP AT HIS RESIDENCE AND THEY DROVE TO THE LOCATION NORTH OF START, ON HWY. 595. (SEE TRANSCRIBED STATEMENT FOR MORE INFORMATION)**

**ON 07-18-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 9:00 A.M., I TOOK A RECORDED STATEMENT FROM PAMELA KAY LEWIS. MRS. LEWIS IS AN EMPLOYEE AT MED LIFE AMBULANCE SERVICE. SHE SAID SHE WAS DISPATCHED TO HWY. 595 ON THE MORNING OF 06-17-07 AT APPROXIMATELY 1:40 A.M. UPON ARRIVING AT THE SCENE SHE SAID THAT SHE NOTICED A SUBJECT LAYING IN THE SOUTHBOUND LANE OF THE HWY. AND A MALE SUBJECT KNEELING BY HIM. MRS. LEWIS SAID THAT THE MAN KNEELING TOLD HER THAT THE SUBJECT LYING IN THE ROAD WAS BLEEDING FROM HIS HEAD AND HE HAD BEEN TRYING TO STOP THE BLEEDING WITH SOME T-SHIRTS. MRS. **DETAILS OF COMPLAINT OR INCIDENT**

On Sunday, June 17, 2007 at approximately 0153 hrs I was advised by RPSO dispatch to be en route to Lake Erwin Rd. Reference to a person being drug by a vehicle. RPSO advised that the call came in from American Medical Response. RPSO advised that AMR stated that the incident occurred on Lake Erwin Rd. And that the call had come in to them Via Ouachita 911. Morehouse Parish was contacted because Lake Erwin is in Morehouse Parish. RPSO advised that a Supervisor with MPSO advised that Lake Erwin Rd. Was in Richland.

Upon my arrival at approximately 0204 hrs Med Life ambulance was already on scene at attending to a male patient. There were several vehicles parked on the road at the time. I made contact with a Opal Michelle Lee Ogden. Ogden stated that the injured man was her husband. Ogden stated that they have been married for sixteen years, but had separated in January. Ogden told me that she moved to 298 Lake Erwin Rd. In Morehouse Parish. Ogden said that for the past month Randy had been staying there with her. Ogden stated that tonight she was parked in a drive off Hwy 595 talking to Randy who was in his own vehicle. Ogden said that they were arguing. Ogden said that she left and was headed home. Ogden stated that randy drove behind her and rammed her vehicle with his truck. Ogden stated the she stopped. Ogden stated that her drivers side window was down. Ogden said that randy stood on the running board of her vehicle and was attempting to strike her in the face. Ogden stated that she accelerated away. Ogden stated that Randy fell from the vehicle and struck his head in the pavement. Ogden stated that she left the scene in randy's vehicle to get help. I asked where Randy's vehicle was located. Ogden pointed and stated it's a ford down there. Ogden pointed where several vehicles were parked on the side of the road.

While I was speaking with Ogden Med Life had loaded randy Ogden and was en route wit Richardson Medical Center. I then contacted Dy. Travis Stephenson and advised him that a Investigator needed to be called out. I then observed a man getting into Michelle Ogden vehicle and crank the vehicle. I advised the man that he could not take the vehicle from the location. The man was also attempting to get Michelle Ogden to go with him to the hospital.



I advised him that Michelle also needed to remain there . The man became very irrate and started cursing I attempted to calm the man. Dy. Terry Parrish arrived and was able to calm the man down the man went and got into a truck and left. At the time I was not aware but the vehicle he left in was the one Randy Ogden had been driving. When I learned of this I notified Dy. Parrish to radio Units at the hospital to take control and hold the vehicle. I learned a short time later that Officer Tommy Alexander Dy. Had the vehicle in their control at Richardson Medical Center. Inv. Chuck Stephenson arrived at 02:40 hrs and the scene was turned over to him. Dy. Parrish and I checked the roadway for any tire markings but found none. The only tire markings found was from the driveway where the Ogden had been prior to the incident.

Upon inspection of Michelle Ogdens vehicle I observed body damage to the rear of the vehicle. Inspection of Randy Ogdens vehicle revealed damage to the front of his vehicle.

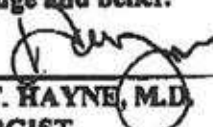

**GENERAL:**

The post mortem examination is requested by Ken Sanders, Assistant Coroner, Richland Parish, LA. The request for the post mortem examination is made in that the decedent, Randy L. Ogden, died a violent death. The request for the post mortem examination is affixed to the final post mortem protocol.

The post mortem examination is conducted at the Mississippi Crime Laboratory Morgue in Jackson, Mississippi at 22:00 hours on 18 June 2007. The remains are identified as those of Randy L. Ogden by Ken Sanders, Assistant Coroner, Richland Parish, LA. Individuals present and attending the post mortem examination are listed in detail on the front page of this report.

The decedent is a Caucasian male appearing the recorded age of 38 years. No clothing, jewelry, valuables and/or personal effects are identified on the remains. The height, weight, and the presence or absence of rigor mortis and livor mortis are listed in detail on the front page of this report.

**TOXICOLOGY:**

Two gray top tubes of blood, one gray top tube of vitreous fluid, one red top tube of blood and one purple top tube of blood are submitted to MedScreens and STL Forensic Toxicology under chain of custody for toxicological analysis. The blood alcohol screening performed by GC (Gas Chromatography) reveals the absence of Ethanol as well as other blood alcohols to include Methanol, Acetone and Isopropanol. The screening for drugs of abuse and medications performed by Enzyme Immunoassay with Gas Chromatography / Mass Spectrometry confirmation reveals the presence of Lorazepam at a concentration of less than 0.025 mcg/ml in the submitted blood toxicology specimen. **PHOTOGRAPHIC DOCUMENTATION:**

**INTERNAL EXAMINATION:**

The body is opened via the usual "Y" incision and subcutaneous adipose tissue over the chest wall is noted to measure to a depth of 1 cm and over the abdomen to a depth of 1 cm. The anterior right and left ribs are reflected en bloc with the sternum in the usual manner. A small amount of clear wetting fluid is present within the right and left pleural cavities. The right lung is noted to have a mass of 720 grams and the left lung is noted to have a mass of 640 grams. The lungs are serially cross-sectioned and a large amount of serosanguineous fluid exudes from the cut surfaces. Examination of the cross-sectioned segments of the lungs fails to reveal evidence of thromboembolic phenomena, tumor, and/or infection though acute congestion as well as pulmonary edema and atelectasis are appreciated to involve both right and left lungs. Examination of the larynx, trachea, and main stem bronchi reveals iatrogenic perilaryngeal hemorrhage. A tracheostomy is noted to be present. Iatrogenic soft tissue hemorrhage of the neck is identified.

The pericardial sac is opened, and a small amount of clear wetting fluid is present within the luminal space. The take off of the great vessels is unremarkable. The heart is noted to have a mass of 350 grams and external examination of the heart reveals no cardiomegaly. No evidence of congestive heart failure is appreciated. The coronary arteries are serially cross-sectioned and no atherosclerotic plugging is appreciated to involve the coronary arteries or their major branches. The heart is serially cross-sectioned and the right ventricle measures up to 0.5 cm in thickness and the left ventricle measures up to 1.5 cm in thickness. Examination of the cross-sectioned segments of the heart fails to reveal evidence of acute or remote infarction. The four cardiac valves are unremarkable and no evidence of congenital heart disease is found. The aorta is examined through its entire course and reveals mild atherosclerotic plaquing that is calcified and non-ulcerated.



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The abdominal cavity is opened and a small amount of clear wetting fluid is present within the luminal space.

The vertebral column and rib cage as well as the sternum and pelvis are palpated and visually inspected and no fractures are identified.

The liver assumes its usual right upper quadrant abdominal location and is noted to have a mass of 1820 grams. The capsule is intact and no subcapsular contusions are appreciated. The liver is serially cross-sectioned and a moderate amount of serosanguineous fluid exudes from the cut surfaces. Examination of the cross-sectioned segments of the liver reveals acute hepatic congestion. The gallbladder is found at the inferior surface of the liver and is noted to measure 7 cm in length and contains approximately 20 cc of green bile. No gallstones are identified. The mucosal surface of the gallbladder is unremarkable. The biliary tree is patent to the duodenum.

The spleen assumes its usual left upper quadrant abdominal location and is noted to have a mass of 170 grams. The capsule is intact and no subcapsular contusions are appreciated. The spleen is serially cross-sectioned and a moderate amount of serosanguineous fluid exudes from the cut surfaces. Examination of the cross-sectioned segments of the spleen reveals acute splenic congestion. The malpighian corpuscles are of normal size and number. A section of vertebral bone marrow is grossly unremarkable. Perihilar and mesenteric lymphadenopathy is appreciated and the individual lymph nodes measure up to 1.1 and 0.3 cm respectively. The lymph nodes are serially cross-sectioned and reveal reactive lymphoid hyperplasia with mild anthracotic pigment deposition of the perihilar lymph nodes.

The right and left kidneys assume the usual retroperitoneal location and each is noted to have a mass of 160 grams. The capsules strip with ease revealing smooth cortical surfaces bilaterally. The kidneys are serially cross-sectioned and moderate amount of serosanguineous fluid exudes from the cut surfaces. Examination of the cross-sectioned segments of the kidneys reveals acute renal congestion bilaterally. The calyces are unremarkable. The ureters are single bilaterally and patent to the urinary bladder. The urinary bladder contains approximately 40 cc of yellow urine and the mucosal surface of the urinary bladder is unremarkable. A urinary catheter is present within the luminal space of the urinary bladder. The prostate is serially cross-sectioned and no abnormalities are identified. The external genitalia is unremarkable.

The esophagus is examined and no abnormalities are identified. The stomach contains 50 cc of tan liquid that fails to reveal an odor of ethyl alcohol. No particulate tablet or capsule material is identified within the luminal space of the stomach. The mucosal surface of the stomach is unremarkable. The small bowel, vermiform appendix and large bowel are unremarkable. Well-formed stool is found within the luminal space of the small bowel and large bowel. The mesentery and omentum are unremarkable. No adhesions are identified to involve the organs of the abdominal cavity. The rectum and anus are unremarkable and reveal no evidence of trauma or disease.

The pancreas assumes its usual retroperitoneal location and is noted to have a mass of approximately 160 grams. The structure is serially cross-sectioned and no abnormalities are identified. The right and left adrenal glands assume the usual suprarenal location and each is noted to have a mass of approximately 5 grams. The structures are serially cross-sectioned and no abnormalities are identified. The thyroid gland is found on the anterior surface of the trachea and is noted to have a mass of approximately 25 grams. The structure is serially cross-sectioned and no abnormalities are identified.

The scalp is reflected, and a subgaleal hemorrhage is appreciated. The calvarium is removed and no evidence of an epidural hemorrhage is seen though a subdural and diffuse subarachnoid hemorrhage is seen. Approximately 160 cc of blood is identified within the subdural space. The leptomeninges are thin and delicate. The brain is noted to have a mass of 1440 grams. The gyri are widened and the sulci are narrowed consistent with mild cerebral edema. The Circle of Willis and supportive vascular structures are unremarkable. The brain is serially cross-sectioned revealing the previously described changes of mild cerebral edema as well as contusions measuring up to 0.3 cm involving the right and left cerebral hemispheres. In addition, contusions measuring up to 0.4 cm are identified involving the brain stem. No evidence of tumor or infection is appreciated to involve the cross-sectioned segments of the brain. Approximately 20 cc of intraventricular hemorrhage is seen. The dura is stripped and fractures to involve the calvarium and base of the skull are seen.

**EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:**

Examination of the scalp reveals the scalp to be covered with brown hair. The decedent is noted to have a short black beard and short black mustache each consistent with a 3-4 day growth. No goatee is identified. The eyes are blue, the sclera are clear, the pupils are fixed bilaterally at 0.8 cm. The dentition is in adequate repair. Body heat is absent. The decedent is circumcised.

Remote injuries consist of multiple scars identified over the posterior surface of the right upper extremity measuring up to 2 cm and over the posterior surface of the left upper extremity measuring up to 6 cm. Scars are identified over the anterior surfaces of the right and left lower extremities measuring up to 2 cm. Scars are identified over the anterior surface of the left upper extremity measuring up to 1 cm.

Acute medical intervention consists of a nasogastric tube inserted in the right nares held in apposition with tape. An airway is identified in the mouth and a tracheostomy tube is inserted over the anterior surface of the neck. Four cardiac electrode leads are identified over the chest. An intravenous catheter is inserted in the right antecubital fossa and is held in apposition with tape. An intravenous catheter is inserted in the left antecubital fossa and is held in apposition with tape. A pulse oximeter lead is attached to the 3<sup>rd</sup> digit of the right hand. A medical identification band is affixed about the right wrist. Three medical identification bands are affixed about the wrist left wrist. An intravenous catheter is inserted over the dorsal surface of the left hand. An identification tag is affixed to the left great toe. A urinary catheter is inserted in the usual manner.

Acute traumatic injuries include a 4 cm abrasion identified over the right superior side of the forehead. Abrasions are identified over the right upper back and inferior back that measure up to 10 cm. A 3 cm abrasion is identified over the proximal posterior surface of the right forearm and 1 cm abrasions are identified over the dorsal surfaces of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> digits of the right hand. An 8 cm abrasion is identified over the anteromedial surface of the right arm. A 12 cm contusion is identified over the anteromedial surface of the left arm. A 1 cm abrasion is identified over the anterolateral surface of the left shoulder. Abrasions are identified over the dorsal surfaces of the thumb and 2<sup>nd</sup> digit of the left hand. Abrasions are identified over the anterior surface of the right knee and right shin measuring up to 17 cm. The fingernails are intact and no tears of the fingernails are identified and no foreign tissue is identified underneath the fingernails. The long bones of the right and left upper and lower extremities are palpated and no fractures are identified. Internal examination reveals a fracture coursing through the right petrous ridge and then posteriorly and to the left of the right and left posterior fossae. Fractures are identified over the posterolateral right and left sides of the cranial vault.

He was on the lane going south with his head kind of toward the yellow line and his foot toward the side and he was kind of at an angle and um, he was probably about maybe a foot or two away the edge of the road and um, we got out of the truck and when I walked around, there was a gentleman standing or squatted down at his head and he stood up and he said he's bleeding from the head, he's bleeding from the head. I've got stuff on his head. I can't get it to stop. I immediately heard the snoring respirations and gurgling. There was a lady that was off on a cell phone. She walked up. She was kind of like standing a few feet away and she walked up. I immediately

got a stethoscope out. I started listening to his chest. His chest was full of fluid. Whether it was blood or whatever, I don't know but anyway, I knew then how bad the situation was and I was told on the way that she had drug him by the vehicle. With his chest being that full, I knew that his injuries were pretty bad, possibly internal, so I asked her, you know, well, how did, I said how far did you drag him. She immediately started screaming at me, said that she did not drag him, that he stood up on the running rail and was trying to get in the vehicle. I think she said he swung his arm at her or something but she never said that he hit her or anything and she said he fell off and this is where he lay. She said he's laying where he lay. I said okay, fine. I said we've got to go. My partner grabbed the spine board. There was an older gentleman that was just standing far off that was very quiet. He had glasses on and um, he never said anything but he came, he helped us. The guy that was standing at the head, he held the man's head and he knew what to do as far as to hold his arms for us to get him in, to move his spine in one way. So the other gentleman helped me and my partner, we got on the spine board. About that time, Kenny um, he's a Start Fire. His wife is Wendy?

Stephenson: Temple.

Lewis: Kenny Temple pulled up and I had asked the gentleman at the head since he acted like he knew what he was doing, I asked him, I said look can you ride in with me cause I knew the extent of his injuries were bad and he said sure, sure, my wife's a nurse. I'll go. I'll help, I'll help. So about that time, we were getting him on the spine board onto the stretcher, Kenny walks up and I told the gentleman I didn't need him anymore. I said Kenny, please ride in with me. Kenny jumped in the back. We got a line started. My partner was turning the vehicle around while we are in the back working on him. We didn't delay any scene time and then we got to the end of the road and Kenny knew exactly where to go cause Darren is just part-time. He doesn't work Rayville a whole lot or Start, so Kenny jumped in the front, drove. My partner immediately got back into the back and while we are in the back, he um, like I said he's doing the snoring respirations. It's gurgling. I got the line on him. We got oxygen on him and he act like he was fixing to quit breathing on me. I got the blade out and was fixing to try and incubate him. Well, once I pulled his tongue up and it opened his airway, he started breathing better on his own. Well, at this time he's on a spine board, the C-collar and headlocks because I didn't know he had a neck injury or what was going on at that time. Well, he started breathing on his own, he had good stats, um, I don't

recall what his blood pressure and pulse was doing at this time. I'm thinking his pulse was up and his blood pressure was like on the normal and I may have that backwards. I have to have my report in front of me and immediately we arrived at the hospital. Nobody rode in with us. It was just me, my partner and Kenny, Kenny driving us in and um, we turned care over to the hospital at that time.

Stephenson: When you arrived at the scene, you say that you saw the man, did you see the man holding the guy's head that was laying in the road?

Lewis: Yeah, he had like two or three t-shirts holding his head cause he had a uh...

Stephenson: Did he tell you what his name was or do you remember?

Lewis: No, sir, he never told me but I've been told since.

Stephenson: Now you say you saw the subject laying in the road. He was laying in a south bound lane, you said.

Lewis: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: And you say his feet was approximately what a couple of feet off the side of the road but he was laying in the road, right?

Lewis: He was laying in the road and he was at an angle with his like feet pointing northwest and his head was pointing southeast.

Lewis: Yeah, she was kind of standing a few feet off on a cell phone and walked up and leaned over with me.

Stephenson: Okay and then Kenny Temple...

Lewis: Okay, Kenny came afterwards but there was a gentleman.

Stephenson: And then another gentleman. Did you see anybody else there?

Lewis: No, sir.

Stephenson: Were there any of our deputies there?

Lewis: Um, I never saw any of them but my partner said when we got him in the truck they had come up and he saw them.

Stephenson: Okay.

Lewis: And I don't know who the deputies were.

Stephenson: So you all got him stable, got him loaded and got him to the hospital and that's when you turned care over to Richardson Medical Center?

Lewis: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Is that correct?

Lewis: Yes, sir and see we were only on scene, I mean, just a few minutes.

Stephenson: Did Randy Ogden, the guy that you all worked on, did he, was he able to respond to anything that you all asked him to do or...?

Lewis: No, sir.

Stephenson: He wasn't responding?

Lewis: He was totally unresponsive and his pupils were dilated and unresponsive.

I went up to the scene and then I came here and then I went to the hospital, you know, back and forth but they were steadily working on Randy Ogden in the emergency room.

Stephenson: When I got there and they worked on him from the time I was there until the time they airlifted him to Shreveport.

Lewis: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Were you still there when they airlifted him?

Lewis: Yes, sir, I stayed right there. I never left. I, I because the man was pretty bad off.

Stephenson: And was you ever in there with the doctor when they were working on him?

Lewis: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Okay, did they have to do a trach?

Lewis: Yes, sir, they ended up doing a trach. He tried several times to incubate. He could not get him incubated. I even tried twice to incubate him.

Stephenson: Did they say why they couldn't do that?

Lewis: Um, no, sir, he never stated but I know when I went in, I could see the trachea and the epiglottis perfectly and I've got the tube, I mean, I visualized it, got the end of the tube in the trachea maybe a half inch and I

couldn't get it in any further.

Lewis: So I quit and then I tried again and it was the same thing. Um, he had got it one time and the nurse said when he was doing the cry-point pressure that it felt like it had went in but it was in his stomach.

Lewis: Yes, sir, he was right there with me. We were in and out of the room. We were working with them. We were doing everything we could to give them extra hands.

This is Investigator Chuck Stephenson with the Richland Parish Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 1:25 p.m., July 5, 2007. I'm going to take a recorded statement from James Martin Gill.

Stephenson: You go by Martin, right?

Gill: Right.

Stephenson: Martin I've got to read you your Statement of Miranda Rights. "You have the right to remain silent. Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of law. You have the right to talk to a lawyer and have him present with you while you are being questioned. Stephenson: And she moved from down there where they lived, 577 south of Waverly, I think.

Lee: Correct.

Stephenson: And moved up here and rented a trailer from Noel Robertson.

Lee: She moved, see her mother lives about a mile from that trailer. So she moved in with her mother while she was waiting on this trailer. So she lived with her mother from January to middle of May, I would assume, first of May and then she moved in the trailer.

Stephenson: Did she buy the trailer?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: The trailer belongs to Noel?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: She's renting it from...?

Lee: Noel.

Stephenson: Okay, when she moved in, do you know, you say about the middle of May she moved into the trailer?

Lee: First of May, middle of May.

Stephenson: Okay, were her and Randy separated during this time?

Lee: He had, yeah, they were separated, even filed for divorce. Now he had been coming and staying a couple nights a week at her mother's with her and the kids but, cause the rooms were limited but the way I understand it, soon as she moved in that trailer he was staying there almost every night.

Stephenson: Okay.

Lee: Probably 90% of the nights.

Stephenson: Do you know why she left and moved up here?

Lee: Yes, he had a drinking problem and a womanizing problem and a drug

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problem.

Stephenson: Did she catch him with another woman or heard he was with another woman?

Lee: Yeah, she, she has saw him go to women after she left but I think before that she just, I, I think Chuck he's been wrong six, seven years and she knew about it, just finally got enough.

Stephenson: Have you ever witnessed them fighting physically?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: You witnessed them arguing?

Lee: I, I've witnessed them, well, arguing, they were pretty good keeping to themselves, you know. Now, I've witnessed bruises and marks on her that she said come from him.

Stephenson: She told you they come from him?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: Have you ever had a problem with Randy physically, you and him?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: You all ever get into an argument or anything like that?

Lee: No, no, me and Randy got along good, you know, I definitely would take up for Michelle and I had told her what I knew about him. Of course, he knew that so he would stay clear of me so I wouldn't, I knew his secrets but no, we ain't never fought.

Stephenson: He wouldn't do nothing in front of you cause he was scared it would get back to her?

Lee: Right.

Stephenson: Okay, let's talk about Martin a little bit. They just work together? Is he a family friend or...?

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Lee: We, Michelle graduated with his older brother so she's known them and that family, we're originally from Winnsboro so we lived close to them, we've known them all our life. Martin I did not know cause I was, well, I knew who he was but see I'm a little older. I'm a little older than even than the older brother but yeah, she knew them well before she went to work there.

Stephenson: Well I know when I got up there that night Michelle told me, when we were looking at her vehicle, that a couple of those things on the back of her vehicle was where Randy, she said Randy had run into her. She said it was already there, that it happened...

Lee: 2 or 3 weeks before.

Stephenson: 2 or 3 weeks before that?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: But she said there was another spot that was, that it happened that night.

Lee: Fresh.

Stephenson: So he had rammed her vehicle like that before?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: Do you know where that happened at?

Lee: No, but she had the kids with her. I know that and she was traveling pretty good cause, you know, I pulled, I, I she came down to where I work and I saw the damage and I asked her and she told me, did not say where they were but she said, you know, I was leaving and Randy didn't want me to leave. I don't know where.

Stephenson: Did she say she reported that anywhere?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: She didn't or you...?

Lee: Did not report it I don't think.

Stephenson: So when we left here after I took Michelle's statement we left and went to the hospital. You remember all that?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: And you, Martin and Michelle were together.

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: We went to the hospital, which it was a pretty busy place at the hospital. I never did get a chance to talk to Randy because they were working on him the whole time he was there til they airlifted him to Shreveport and then I met, I remember you calling...

Lee: Randy's parents.

Stephenson: Randy's parents, Gene and Margie, from here, was it on your cell phone or...?

Lee: I used your phone.

Stephenson: Yeah, okay, you used my phone. You called them for me and told them about it. How were they on the telephone when you talked to them?

Lee: Well, that time of the morning, Mrs. Margie answered and I said Mrs. Margie, this is Greg Lee and is Mr. Gene, can I speak to him, is he there and I knew he was there and she said it's Randy isn't it and I said yes ma'am and she didn't say anything else. She just, and I don't think that they sleep in the same bed cause she was gone a little while.

Stephenson: Yeah.

Lee: Went down the hall and got him.

Stephenson: So going back, you think the reason they separated for that time was because of their marital problems with his drinking and maybe her drinking. You know, they all, you know, and then him possibly having an affair with somebody and but, you know, cause I'm hearing, you know, I'm hearing some people were telling me that they were trying to get back together, you know, fix everything. That they were trying to get back together that's why he was staying up there with her.



Lee: He had told her he had not fooled with drugs in about 2 or 3 months. You know, she was reluctant to believe that quick and uh...

Stephenson: But you were not at the little get-together they had before all this happened?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: You were at home by yourself?

Lee: Right.

Stephenson: So, and you said that Martin Gill called you, told you that Michelle had called him?

Lee: Right.

Stephenson: And told him about it. Do you know a David Templeton or the guy, Noel? Have you ever met Noel?

Lee: Not til then. I didn't know him til then.

Stephenson: Okay, you didn't know him until that night?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: So you probably don't know any of the rest of them?

Lee: Michelle told me she didn't know some of the people there and that's why Chuck I was asking you that night to check them. I mean, I couldn't understand why the truck was gone, you know, who these people were.

Stephenson: Right. Joey Dotson, he's supposed to be from...?

Lee: Yeah.

Stephenson: Do you know him?

Lee: Yeah.

Stephenson: Okay, he was at the party that night. See everybody that I've talked to...

Lee: Yeah, yeah.

Stephenson: So far had already left bout 10:30.

Lee: Except Noel.

Stephenson: Except Noel. It was Noel, Michelle and Randy and I think the kids were in the house.

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: And Noel was telling me, you know, that they were just sitting around there and all of a sudden, Randy just got up and left and they didn't know why. You don't know, has Michelle said anything about him getting a phone call or somebody calling him and making him mad or what?

Lee: Chuck, I'm just grasping at straws and maybe I'm looking at the wrong thing but I'm thinking he's going up the road to do drugs and don't want to do it in front of them but maybe I'm wrong.

Stephenson: You ever seen him do drugs?

Lee: No.

Stephenson: What did you hear he was on?

Lee: Well, he was doing cocaine and crack-cocaine and then he had some, some kind of pill or whatever. I'm not familiar but he would drink and stay up all night and then he would take in the morning so he could go that day.

Stephenson: Do you know if Michelle was doing any drugs?

Lee: Michelle should not because we don't and she always told me she wasn't so...

Stephenson: So you never witnessed her doing any?

Lee: I've never witnessed her and I feel like she's telling the truth and I think she would give you a blood sample.

Stephenson: Yeah.

Lee: Or whatever you ask for. Now she did, you know, I guess I was out of line, because I knew something was going to happen to Randy and I didn't want to say anything bad about him but I told her that night I wanted all that stuff checked out because this needed to quit. If he was a drug user and it was going to get this ugly, this needed to stop. If he needed to go to jail for possession and it straightened him up, that's what I wanted to happen.

Stephenson: Right.

Lee: But because, you know, I told Michelle, I said here you are at your house with your kids and this crap is going on. Now, Michelle was upset that night and that's what I asked her did he go up the road to do drugs because she goes down that road and he's sitting on the side of the road, you know. Why else would you do that? I mean, I don't know but anyway she told me that when she got there, some girl and I knew none of these names, said a boy pulled out a pill and was showing her husband and said this one will knock you on your ass, be careful when you do it and she caught onto it and I don't know any of the names, maybe Michelle can tell you, maybe she probably don't want this to be known now because she's trying now not to smear Randy's name.

Stephenson: Okay.

Lee: But the girl said Michelle I seen him telling Randy the same thing, be careful when you take this cause it's strong but...

Stephenson: Are you talking about on the side of the road that night?

Lee: No, this was when Michelle got home about 8:00. The girl said look earlier this guy over here was showing them pills and telling them to be careful.

Stephenson: Has Michelle ever told you what may have happened while they were on the side of the road? The reason he was mad or the reason she left or what, anything?

Lee: Chuck, I think that's what happened, when he drink severely, that was pretty regularly and I think he had probably been drinking, know what he had done that day? He fished with the kids. I figured, knowing what he had done, he probably started drinking about 1:00. Now Michelle said he swamp with that wine at 12 or whatever, 11 or 12 so, you know, he was,

had to be drunk.

Stephenson: Okay Randy...

Lee: Greg.

Stephenson: Greg, I'm sorry. I appreciate you coming in. I may have to get you back in here cause I'm trying, I have to put all of this together and then I turn it in to the District Attorney's office and they'll read it and the more people I talk to, the better kind of feel of what happened.

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: And I'm going to get this figured out. You know, I'm right in the middle. You know, I didn't know Randy. I didn't know Michelle. So I'm trying to, you know, there's two, you know, two families that's really hit hard by this. There's several people that's hit hard by this and I'm trying to do what's best for both sides of the family and try and figure out what's happened, okay?

Lee: Yes.

Stephenson: That a way, I can say well, no, this didn't happen and then this didn't happen and you know, with a good conscience, telling them I'd done all I could to find out what happened. That's my job so...

Lee: I understand.

Stephenson: I appreciate you coming in.

Lee: And we do not want to smear his name. We understand what they are going thru, you know but it, I think they're making it hard on Michelle as far as getting past it and do whatever they need to do with the kids.

Stephenson: Right. Well, it's going to be hard on everybody and it probably, it may not ever get better. We'll just have to see. It's approximately 11:00 a.m., July 5, 2007. This concludes the statement of Gregory G. Lee.

This is Investigator Chuck Stephenson with the Richland Parish Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 9:00 a.m., July 2, 2007. I'm taking a recorded statement from Juandine Templeton.

Stephenson: Juandine, would you state your name, address and phone number for me please?

Templeton: Juandine Templeton, 1332 Adcock Road, Rayville, Louisiana. My phone number is 318-728-3551.

Stephenson: Okay Juandine, I'm just going to talk to you a little bit about an incident, well, an incident that happened and you and your husband, David, had gone over to some folks' house on the 17<sup>th</sup> of last month, well, 16<sup>th</sup> of last month, I believe. It was on a Saturday night and can you just start about, tell me from like 7:00 p.m. that Saturday afternoon until you went home that night and tell me where you all were and what you all were doing?

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## STATEMENT OF CLOIS KING

This is Deputy Chuck Stephenson with the Richland Parish Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 11:30 a.m., June 28, 2007. I'm taking a recorded statement from Clois King.

Stephenson: Clois, would you state your name, address and phone number for me please?

King: Uh, Clois King, 155 Williams Lane, uh, Rayville, Louisiana, uh, 318-614-5242.

Stephenson: Okay, thank you Clois. We're going to talk about an incident that happened on the 17<sup>th</sup> of this month involving Michelle and Randy Ogden. I was gone from my office a little while yesterday and when I came back, I had a message to call you and I called you and you told me that you needed to talk and told me some things that I needed to know about this case that I'm working and you told me a little bit on the phone and then you came in this morning and we talked and what I want you to do is, you said something about something you overheard in a feed store in Delhi. It's been about a month, a little over a month ago now and if you can recall the day that's fine but I want you to tell me the name of the feed store and what you heard and who you heard it from when you went in the store. Can you do that for me?

King: Oh, yes, sir, uh, well, it's the Delhi Feed Store, I guess is what they call it. Uh, I had walked in there to get some uh, some spray for my garden and some cat feed and Michelle and uh, a boy she calls Bubba. Like I said, I still don't know...

Stephenson: Michelle who you talking about?

King: Uh, Ogden would be her name now.

Stephenson: Okay, go ahead.

King: And uh, he was wanting to go, you know, south of Waverly down there and said something about killing Randy Ogden and she said no, it couldn't happen in, you know, Madison Parish. She wouldn't never get him out of, you know, trouble and I don't know, two or three other things about, you know, she didn't want nothing to happen and she, you know, would get rid

of Randy thru a divorce and he just kept raving and the Gill boy, I don't know his first name, he...

Stephenson: Does he work at the store?

King: Yes, sir, his mother is the one that owns it.

Stephenson: Okay, Michelle and Gill work at the store?

King: Yes.

Stephenson: What about this Bubba guy, does he work there?

King: No, like I said, I take that to be Michelle's brother cause I believe that's what she called him, Bubba.

Stephenson: Okay and what about the Gill boy?

King: Uh, he walked off and he told uh, Bubba that he wouldn't have to worry about killing Randy, he was going to do it if he, you know, didn't leave Michelle alone about taking them kids around that ole' crazy man and woman, which I know that ain't right but anyway...

Stephenson: Who do you think he was talking about?

King: He was talking about Margie and Gene.

Stephenson: Okay. Ogden? Randy's momma...

King: Yes.

Stephenson: Okay.

King: Yeah cause evidently they was against Michelle you know for whatever she done. I figured an affair but anyway and uh, while he was over there, well, he asked me what I wanted and then he walked off, you know, to get it and he said if you could make it look like an accident, you know, if you can get him to get him up on your running board and you know take off and then throw on the brakes and throw him off on the ground, maybe, you know, kill him or mess him up, he'd be out of your hair anyhow and

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uh, Michelle or that boy Bubba, now he's, like I said, a big fella and he's just like dumping the trash can and falls on the ground and said you know it's just like dumping the trash and I was going out the door but like I said, they were still talking about different ways doing it.

Stephenson: Did you say something about them saying earlier about having a surprise party for him or anything like that?

King: No, yeah, I, no, they act like they was planning a surprise party. You know, they didn't try and cover any of that up, you know. If it had been me, I believe I would have shut my damn mouth and waited until there wasn't nobody but the three of us in there.

Stephenson: Yeah. Well and this was during the daytime, the store was opened.

King: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Where is this store at over there?

King: Uh, right by Terrell Grain office. I don't remember the name, well, located by Scott Irrigation. That would probably be it.

Stephenson: Was anyone else in the store beside you and those three people?

King: Yep cause when I walked out, somebody was pulling up out there then but I don't, I don't remember uh, who it was.

Stephenson: Okay, we are going to jump ahead a little bit here. You're saying on the Saturday night before Father's Day, we were talking earlier.

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: You went to Cannon's Grocery to get you some beer or something?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: And what happened then?

King: Uh, well, I walked up to the door, you know, to open it and go in and like I said somebody there at the door and I let them out. Well, I think it was a woman but uh, you know, I could see somebody fussing in there in front of the Powerball machine and I, I let them come thru and I come thru the

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door and I noticed or recognized the fella, you know, that was doing the fussing and...

Stephenson: Who was that?

King: That was the Gill boy.

Stephenson: Okay and you don't know his first name?

King: No, uh...

Stephenson: But he was the same one you saw in the store that day?

King: Yeah. Yeah, it's the same boy and uh, I asked the girl, you know, when he bumped into me well, you know, I spoke to him. He didn't say nothing. He was mumbling bout a slow ass bitch and uh, she said that he was either drunk or mad but said he was mumbling about killing him a Randy Ogden and...

Stephenson: And the lady at the store heard him? That's what she told you he said?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: Do you know who...go ahead.

King: No, you know what, I told the girl she ought to call it then. I said if something comes up at least, you know, it would be verified then but she said what am I going to tell them and you know, you think about it.

Stephenson: Yeah. Do you know who the girl was?

King: I don't know her name. I really don't but I could probably go back out there and...

Stephenson: Point her out?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: About what time was it when that you went in the store that night?

King: Between 9:30 and uh, 10:00 at night. Like I said, she was standing right

there and the clock was over her head and I want to say it was 20 minutes to 10.

Stephenson: That's at night, right?

King: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Had you been drinking that day?

King: Oh, yes, sir.

Stephenson: How much had you had to drink that day?

King: Well, me and my next door neighbor done drank a 12-pack but his wife cooked and I had eat. Like I said, I wanted some more beer. I had just come in that day bout 3:00 and uh...

Stephenson: So you all drank a 12-pack at your house and then ate and you went to Cannon's to get you some more beer?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: How many people were in the store, when you walked in the store, you say a lady or somebody, you opened the door and they came out, you went in and then you saw this Gill guy, you could tell he was mad about something?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: And then who else was in the store? You see anybody else in there?

King: The two people behind the counter, that's all I seen.

Stephenson: That's all you saw. Were they both females?

King: Yep.

Stephenson: But you don't remember their names, you just know what they look like?

King: Uh, yeah. Well, I know, I know Sheridan and uh, that girl Barbie, the little skinny girl and her momma and it's two new ones, which when I, when I

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remembered all this uh, day before yesterday, Tuesday, I had went up to Cannon's. You know, I had come in. I wanted to drink a beer or two, you know, before I laid down and had to leave that night and it uh, like I said, I remembered all of it. I kept, you know, thinking it was a, there was something that I dreamed, you know, but no, it all come back to me. I remembered who the boy was and everything.

Stephenson: Okay, I may need to get you to go out there with me and let you point the girl out for me, see if she's working today.

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: So I can talk to her. You told me earlier about you said that Michelle had said they couldn't do it in Richland Parish?

King: Yeah.

Stephenson: And for what reason?

King: No, in uh, Madison Parish.

Stephenson: Oh, in Madison Parish, okay.

King: Yeah, cause Margie and Gene, you know, their uh, influence, I guess, in the neighborhood but uh, she said it couldn't happen up there at her house and that's, you know, that's part of them other two, Gill and the Bubba dude talking back and forth about how to make it look like an accident and uh, she said that if it happened, it would have to happen in Richland Parish cause uh, a Mr. Bubba or somebody uh, not Bubba, Billy, Mr. Billy, that was who she said.

Stephenson: Mr. Billy?

King: Yeah, signed a restraining order. That would be a judge wouldn't it?

Stephenson: Yeah, usually but she said what?

King: Uh, he wouldn't prosecute her.

Stephenson: And then you said somebody had said something about Franklin Parish?

King: Yeah, the Gill boy said if he could get him to Franklin, you know, that's between the plotting and everything, how, you know, make it look like an accident. He said I bet I could get away with it down there cause Baron and the sheriff, you know, Steve Pylant, pretty tight. They wouldn't even investigate it.

Stephenson: Baron who?

King: Uh, Gill.

Stephenson: Who is that?

King: Uh, that's one of the Gill's boy cousins, second or third cousin but uh, this fella Bubba here, he said north of Start or Start would be perfect cause he said I know the investigator and if I tell him it's an accident, you know, he won't investigate and like I said, he never did say a name or you know, who it might be. Stephenson: Well, Clois, I appreciate you coming in here and if I need you again, I've got your phone number and I'll get back in touch with you, okay?

King: Yeah, I just hope it turns out to be something. Like I said, I don't believe Randy needed to die like he did and then if it was an accident, it needs to be, you know, proven an accident.

**STATEMENT OF DAVID WAYNE TEMPLETON**

This is Investigator Chuck Stephenson of the Richland Parish Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 9:45 a.m., June 21, 2007. I'm taking a statement from David Wayne Templeton of 1332 Adcock Road, Rayville, Louisiana, phone number is 728-3551.

Stephenson: David, I'm going to talk to you about where you were on the night of the 16<sup>th</sup> of this month, which was a Saturday night. Can you start like at maybe when you left your house that afternoon, where you went...

Templeton: Okay.

Stephenson: And what transpired after that.

Templeton: Okay. Well, a friend of mine and his girlfriend came from Winnsboro.

Stephenson: Okay who...?

Templeton: His name's Joey Dotson.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: And her name is Carol. I'm not sure about her last name. I don't know her last name.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: I'll think of it in a minute but they came to my house and uh, Joey had been reloading some pistol cartridges and Noel's boys like to shoot and mine so mine was gone doing something so we went to Noel's house.

Stephenson: Noel who?

Templeton: Robertson.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: Going to let them boys shoot them pistol bullets up.

Stephenson: Where does Noel live?

Templeton: Right beside...

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Stephenson: Do you know his address?

Templeton: I know it's uh, I don't know.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: I want to say Highway 595 but I, I...

Stephenson: But you went to Noel Robertson's house. About what time was that, do you know?

Templeton: Uh, about 6:00 or so I want to say.

Stephenson: P.M.?

Templeton: Yep.

Stephenson: Okay go ahead.

Templeton: And we sat around, the boys wasn't around so we started shooting the pistol a little bit and uh, Noel cooked supper. We had brought a few shrimp up and we sat around and eat shrimp and just visited.

Stephenson: Who all was at the house while you all were eating?

Templeton: Uh, me and just the four of us and Noel, his wife.

Stephenson: What's his wife's name?

Templeton: Noel?

Stephenson: Yes.

Templeton: Carrie.

Stephenson: All right.

Templeton: Well, now that I think of it, it was later than that cause she works nights and she was already gone to work when we got there.

Stephenson: Okay so Carrie wasn't there?

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Templeton: She, she left when we got there.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: So it was right at 7:00.

Stephenson: All right. You all ate supper and then what happened after supper?

Templeton: Well, after supper, we sat around and we noticed that the neighbors had a fire going and Carol and my wife Juandine liked to burn with the other girl so, you know, we hung around a little while and we went over there where they had the fire going and...

Stephenson: All of you all went over there?

Templeton: Yep. Everybody rode across the yard in Joey's truck.

Stephenson: Whose house was it that you all went to? Can you tell me a name?

Templeton: I guess it's Michelle...

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: Ogden.

Stephenson: Okay and her husband Randy?

Templeton: Randy.

Stephenson: So you all went over to their house?

Templeton: Yep.

Stephenson: What did you all do over there?

Templeton: We sat around the fire and uh, Juandine and Carol were drinking uh, green apple something. I, I'm not much of a drinker. I drank 3 or 4 beers and uh, Joey was drinking Coors, we were drinking Coors Light. Uh, Noel was drinking Bud Light.

Stephenson: When you all got over there, who all was there?

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Templeton: Uh, when we went over there, it was our group of 5 and then it was uh, Ryan, the only thing, I think his name's Blackwell, I'm not sure. I don't know. I've been around him a little bit.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: Him and his wife, Annie, and then it was uh, Michelle and Randy.

Stephenson: And you all were sitting outside their house?

Templeton: Yep. Well, the kids, they have rope swings that they swim or play right there at their trailer and the kids had been over there, my son and my nephew was with me. They had been over there playing with the kids and swimming and uh...

Stephenson: So you all got over there about what time?

Templeton: To their house?

Stephenson: Yeah.

Templeton: Uh, it was after dark so I'm going to say probably 8:30 or 9:00.

Stephenson: All right. How long did you stay there?

Templeton: Uh, best I can recollect we left there around 10:30.

Stephenson: Who was still there when you left?

Templeton: Uh, Noel, the Ogdens and the other two, Annie and her husband. Everybody was there that was there when we got there.

Stephenson: So you and Joey Dotson and his wife left together?

Templeton: Yep. Yeah, we were all in the same vehicle.

Stephenson: And then you went back to your house?

Templeton: Yep, went to my house and we, we had his daughter, Amber and my son and uh...

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Stephenson: How old are your children?

Templeton: 15, both of them.

Stephenson: While you all were there at the Ogdens' house and you all were sitting outside, you say around a fire?

Templeton: Yes.

Stephenson: Everybody was drinking?

Templeton: Everybody was drinking, just...

Stephenson: Did you hear any arguing going on or nothing?

Templeton: Not at all, nothing. I mean I sat in the chair with Michelle as close as you are, my wife sitting right here and Randy sitting, I mean, the four of us were sitting in four chairs side by side and they were laughing and joking and I mean, not one bit of malice or anger, nothing.

Stephenson: But everybody had been drinking? In your mind, would you say anybody was drunk at that time?

Templeton: I wouldn't say that because they were, Joey's got one of those, he just bought a new truck, one of those Honda Ridgeline and when we drove up, everybody walked around looking at it and I mean it was just, you know, nobody seen this kind of vehicle.

Stephenson: Did you all eat there because you said you all ate supper?

Templeton: We ate at Noel's.

Stephenson: Was Randy or Michelle eating or...?

Templeton: Uh, I didn't notice them eating.

Stephenson: Okay. Where were their kids? Were they all out playing in the lake or...?

Templeton: I think they were inside by then. I, well, I know they were. I think uh, this uh, Ryan and his wife have a little boy. I remember seeing him riding around on a four-wheeler. I know he was there but he didn't come out, I

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think one time while we were sitting there the three kids came out and was messing around but they went back in the house. I think mosquitoes had started eating them up pretty good.

Stephenson: Yeah but nobody got into a fight, got into an argument?

Templeton: No, not even a disagreement. Nothing. I mean, everybody was...

Stephenson: Later on in the night, they said Randy had left the house. Were you there when he left the house?

Templeton: Nope.

Stephenson: So you left about 10:30. Did anybody call you when this happened?

Templeton: Well, it's funny. I got up, I want to say around 2:30. I don't know. I got up, drank me some water, went outside and smoked a cigarette and went back. Before I could lay in the bed, I heard the phone ring so I went back and they had hung up but I looked Caller ID and it was Noel so I called him back and he told me then, he said I'm on my way to the hospital. He said Randy's got hurt and I've been holding his head and you could tell it was a bad situation. I didn't know anything about what was going on.

Stephenson: Did he tell you anything that happened?

Templeton: No.

Stephenson: Okay.

Templeton: No, he's talking to me on the phone and he's driving and he said well, the police is behind me. They done turned their lights on. I'm pulling in at the hospital. I said well, I'll get me some clothes on and I'll be on up there in a minute and I hung up and went in there and told my wife, you know, something has done happened to that Randy. I didn't know if, you know, they had, he had fell on that rope swing or, you know, something...

Stephenson: Did you go to the hospital?

Templeton: I did.

Stephenson: Okay.

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Templeton: I went to the hospital. Uh, uh, what is his name, Stephenson?

Stephenson: Travis?

Templeton: Travis was at the hospital. Well, I went in and the guy at the window, I told him who I was and what I was doing and he said hold on a minute and Travis came out and we talked a minute and he said well, the boy just got arrested.

Stephenson: Talking about Noel?

Templeton: Yeah and I asked him about Randy and he said it don't look good.

Stephenson: Yeah.

Templeton: I said well, Noel told me he was bleeding real bad out of the back of his head but, you know, I couldn't get much out of him. He was pretty much frantic.

Stephenson: Right. What kind of vehicle did Randy have there, do you know?

Templeton: Randy?

Stephenson: Yes.

Templeton: I guess it's that black Ford. That's all I ever saw.

Stephenson: What about Michelle?

Templeton: Uh, a white Sequoia.

Stephenson: So you went to the hospital. Do you know how long you stayed because I didn't see you when I got there?

Templeton: Well, I stayed, I can't remember talking to anybody else. I saw, like I said, I talked to Travis for a minute. I saw maybe one more deputy go in and I, I, he came back out and talked to me. I said well, I'm going to go to the city police and see what the deal is with Noel so I left there and went straight up there and uh, they said they had took him to the DC out there and I said well, I'll go bond him out and she said well, you've got to be, it's got to be a professional bond so that took me out of the loop.

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Stephenson: Yeah.

Templeton: And I rode over here to Ronnie Adcock's place and I, he wasn't around, called him and uh, couldn't get a hold of him. Well, she told me that uh, Tommy Alexander was supposed to call me and she said he'll be back, he'll call you at 4:00 so I went back home and uh, 4:30 rolls around, nobody's called so I went, well, no, I think, well, I can't remember. He called me from the DC and he said everything's fine, you know, they're going to keep me overnight and somebody will be to get me tomorrow. I said well, just wanted to make sure you were all right. He said yeah, I'm fixing to go and try and lay down, get me some sleep.

Stephenson: Have you ever been over to Michelle and Randy's before?

Templeton: Before?

Stephenson: Yeah.

Templeton: Just, I've never been inside. I've been over there with my kids.

Stephenson: How long have they been together over there, do you know?

Templeton: It's been a few months, which, you know, I, I, I get off work, I go home. I don't go out much. This is Investigator Chuck Stephenson of the Richland Parish Sheriff's Office. It's approximately 2:20 p.m., 6/19/07. I'm taking a recorded statement from would you state your name please?

Robertson: Noel Robertson.

Stephenson: And what's your date of birth?

Robertson: 9-1-69.

Stephenson: And what's your address Noel?

Robertson: 870 Lake Irwin Road, Oak Ridge, 71264. I-r-w-i-n.

Stephenson: That's an Oak Ridge address?

Robertson: Oak Ridge, Louisiana 71264.

Stephenson: Okay Noel I want to talk to you about an incident that happened Saturday night, early Sunday morning, I think the date was...

Robertson: The 16<sup>th</sup>, morning of the 17<sup>th</sup>.

Stephenson: Yeah, the 16<sup>th</sup>, night of the 16<sup>th</sup> and the morning of the 17<sup>th</sup>, which was a Saturday and a Sunday. I know, you had already told me before just talking that you were at Randy and Michelle Ogden's house on Lake Irwin Road. Do you know that address there?

Robertson: That's 798 Lake Irwin Road. It's also my property that I rent.

Stephenson: Okay. That's your property, your trailer that they are renting?

Robertson: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: Okay and you were there. Can you tell me who all was there?

Robertson: Well, it was actually, they uh, yeah, uh, David, Juandine and Dustin and then it was Joey, Carol and his daughter Amanda uh, Amber.

Stephenson: They all left before you did?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: Okay. All right. What about Annie and Ryan?

Robertson: They left um, I would probably say, I'm not sure, I'm just guessing cause I don't have no idea what timeframe on that and um...

Stephenson: Okay. Let me rephrase the question. Who was there at the time Randy decided to leave?

Robertson: Randy, I mean, well, it was Michelle, Randy and myself. When Randy left it was Michelle, Randy, Kylie and Colby, which Kylie and Colby were inside playing video games, watching TV, what have you.

Stephenson: So you all were outside. It was you and Randy and Michelle?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: The only three outside?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: And then you say Randy just got up and got in his truck?

Robertson: Well, no, we were sitting there, talking like we had been doing all night and uh, he got up and I assumed he went to get him another beer or a cigarette or what have you and it was a few minutes went by and then all of a sudden, I look, I hear a spin out of gravel. Gravel is kind of thick, you know but he took off, crossed the bridge and I looked at Michelle and I said well, where's Randy going. She said I don't know. I said well, call him and then she said well, I've got his phone right here. I can't call him. She said let me go after him, see what's wrong so she gets in her vehicle and she takes off after him. Well, I'm sitting down by the fire by myself and uh, Kylie she's uh, in the yard at the time that her momma leaves cause she knows that their momma was leaving so she comes out by me by the fire and uh...

Stephenson: How old is Kylie?

Robertson: Uh, Kylie's Sarah's age, I think, she's 10.

Stephenson: Let's back up a little bit. Do you know about how long after everyone else had left the residence that this happened?

Robertson: It hadn't been long because um, I would say less than 30 minutes between when Ryan and Annie left that this happened.

Stephenson: See I had talked to David and he had told me on the phone, he felt like, he thought they had left about 10:30.

Robertson: I mean, like I said I...

Stephenson: Yeah, right, so and they left before Annie and Ryan left so a little bit later?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: So Randy gets in his truck and drives off and Michelle goes to see why?

Robertson: To see what's going on.

Stephenson: He's in his truck, she's in her vehicle?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: What kind of truck does Randy have?

Robertson: Uh, a Ford uh, diesel, I think it's a four-door.

Stephenson: What color is it?

Robertson: Black.

Stephenson: What about Michelle?

Robertson: Uh, a white Toyota Sequoia.

Stephenson: Okay so then what happened?

Robertson: Um, well, I sat there by the fire like I said and all of a sudden my phone rings and I pick it up and it was Michelle crying. She's frantic. She said

Randy has had an accident and he's hit his head or and I need help. Well, she calls me Nu-Nu. She said Nu-Nu come help. Randy's hurt. I need, he's bad so, you know, get on their Ranger cause my wife works at night and my vehicles are broke down right now.

Stephenson: Yeah.

Robertson: So I get on their Polaris Ranger and I haul ass down there and when I get there, he's laying in the road, you know, well, partially in the road, where he was laying when everybody got there.

Stephenson: How far from the house was it down there?

Robertson: Oh, I'm just going to guess, I don't know, maybe that's just, it's less than a mile I suppose.

Stephenson: Okay. So but this was, I mean, I know that the trailer that you are renting them and where you live is in Morehouse Parish.

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: When he left the driveway, he drove into...?

Robertson: Into Richland Parish.

Stephenson: Into Richland Parish and that's where you found Michelle and Randy?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: Okay, when you got there, what did you see?

Robertson: Um, saw uh, Randy laying out on the ground uh, just like he was asleep, snoring, just like a grown man, you know, sleeping. Um, she...

Stephenson: Was he laying on his back?

Robertson: Laying on his back, uh, kind of in a spread legs, spread arms position, uh, just laid out flat. Um and Michelle's screaming and crying. What do I do? What do I do and I told her to call 9-1-1, call 9-1-1. When we get 9-1-1 on the phone, it's just, you know, more waiting and she's talking, 9-1-1 operator is asking her questions and, you know, we give her all the answers that she asked us like uh, I'm trying to find the wound in his head

where he's bleeding from. It's so dark. I can't really uh, see anything and uh, uh...

Stephenson: Did you see any blood?

Robertson: Oh, yes, it was all over my hand.

Stephenson: Did you see any when you got to him or you just...?

Robertson: No, I, I, I didn't notice any blood when I first got there. Um, I got to looking at him, just watching his breathing and things and uh, the next thing I know, um, I looked back on the backside of his head and I saw a little trickle of blood so I put my hand down there and sure enough, I had it on my hand so I eased his neck up, trying to see where his injuries were and uh, I couldn't find a cut of any kind. Um, it was so matted up and bloody, I just couldn't find one so I just put my whole hand back there and applied pressure hopefully to stop what was bleeding, you know, and I held him until the ambulance got there. I don't know if it was 30, it felt like 30 minutes to me. Some people say it was an hour. I'm not sure. Um, and then...

Stephenson: When you got there and saw him laying in the road, where were the two vehicles, do you remember that?

Robertson: Um, Michelle's was uh, slightly in uh, 5 feet or so maybe in front of him. His was behind hers. Um...

Stephenson: You say in front of him, you say his truck was behind her vehicle?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: And then in front of her vehicle was...?

Robertson: Randy.

Stephenson: Was Randy correct.

Stephenson: Okay.

Robertson: Um...

Stephenson: Did Michelle tell you what happen when you got there?

Robertson: She said uh, like I said, she was crying, you know, everything, going crazy. She said that he had jumped up on the running board and they were having an argument and said that uh, he didn't know what he was trying to hit her or what was going on and then uh, somehow slipped off the running board and, you know, the next thing you know, he's laying on the ground hurt and that's kind of where we ended that conversation and went to trying, you know, talk to 9-1-1 and, you know, really tend to him.

Stephenson: Well, I had talked to Michelle. She said that when you got there and she had called 9-1-1 and you were holding Randy, that she had to leave. Can you tell me why she left?

Robertson: Well, cause her kids were home by themselves and I had told her, I said go get somebody to sit with them. I said I've got him, I've got, I think at that time, I was on the phone with 9-1-1 because she kept saying, she didn't know, I mean, she kept saying Lake Irwin Road and I said no, it's not Lake Irwin Road. It's north of Start and uh, I kept calling it 589 and after that, that was even wrong and I picked up my uh, cell phone and I called my wife cause she's a nurse at Conway Hospital um, ICU department cause I've had um, um, CPR training and I just couldn't remember, it's been awhile so I called her in case he stopped breathing so I could know what to do and uh, like I said, 9-1-1 is on one phone, she's on the other phone um, we're not getting anywhere with 9-1-1 as far as getting the ambulance there so I start calling, I start thumbing thru my phone trying to find, like I have Randy Swain's phone, uh, Josh Estis's phone, uh, all kinds of people. I was calling, trying to find somebody that knew me and knew where we would be and uh, finally I got in touch with Randy Odom and to go get Kenny Wayne cause he's an AMR and his wife is too and they live right there and uh, they showed up.

Stephenson: You talking about Kenny Wayne...?

Robertson: Temple.

Stephenson: Temple.

Robertson: Correct, which he ended up riding in the ambulance with us, Randy, well, actually, driving the ambulance to the hospital.

Stephenson: So she left to go get somebody to go to stay with her kids?

Robertson: Correct.

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Stephenson: What vehicle did she leave in?

Robertson: His truck.

Stephenson: Okay and where did she go? Do you know where she went?

Robertson: She, to Annie and Ryan Blackwell.

Stephenson: Okay.

Robertson: Annie sat with them.

Stephenson: Oh, Annie?

Robertson: Annie. A-i, A-n-n-i-e.

Stephenson: She took Annie to her house to stay with the...?

Robertson: I don't know.

Stephenson: You don't know?

Robertson: No.

Stephenson: Were you there when she got back down there?

Robertson: Yes. I never left Randy.

Stephenson: How long was she gone?

Robertson: Not long. It was just...

Stephenson: Two minutes, five minutes?

Robertson: Five minutes, maybe, tops cause it wasn't...

Stephenson: Okay, when she got back down there...?

Robertson: Just long enough to get there and back.

Stephenson: When she got back down there, what did you all do then? Were you still

holding...?

Robertson: I think, I believe uh, I'm still holding, well, I know I was still holding Randy but I believe at this time um, Randy and Kenny had got there and...

Stephenson: Randy Odom you talking about?

Robertson: Yeah because she had pulled Randy's truck up behind Randy Odom and Kenny Wayne and that's, that's when she got back and then she got out and then, you know, the paramedics get there finally and uh, I'm sitting there while she's asking me questions, you know, like what, what's been going on, how far does he, where's his injuries and I'm trying to tell her the best I can and she's like you have any medical training and I said no, my wife's a nurse. I had a little of CPR and that's about it and she said well, I want you to ride in the ambulance with me so we rolled his head, tilted him on the stretcher, um, slid him under, put him on the gurney, rolled him around to the ambulance and then, like I said, Kenny Wayne was there and uh, he had come up and I said well, you know, Kenny has that kind of training so he kind of, he took my place in the ambulance and they uh, headed to the hospital with him then.

Stephenson: And then what did you do?

Robertson: Um, well, I was talking to uh, before this, I was, I was kind of frantic and upset. They wouldn't let her go because and I was worried about the kids. There's a wife that's already lost a husband and kids and I just, I was kind of really kind of ugly to Mr. Jerry and I didn't, it wasn't something I meant to do but just in the heat of the moment. Well, then Terry Parrish shows up and I see Terry and I calm, you know, I calm down. That's somebody that I know, relaxing, um, we talk a little bit...

Stephenson: That was before they got the body loaded or...?

Robertson: That was right before, well, me and Jerry was before and then after the ambulance left, was leaving, that's when me and Terry, when I saw Terry.

Stephenson: Okay.

Robertson: And uh...

Stephenson: So you calm down?



Robertson: Calmed down.

Stephenson: And then you left the scene and you were going to go to the hospital?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: Okay and left Michelle there with the deputies?

Robertson: To be detained or be, talk about what happened.

Stephenson: Okay and then I got there shortly after that and I never did see you that night. I went to the hospital. They said you had got into a little deal and that's, you know, another deal.

Robertson: Yes, sir.

Stephenson: But I just wanted to get you in here to find out who all was at the house that night and did you see them or hear them arguing or anything at the house?

Robertson: Never. Never. I mean, it was just a, it was just a good night, everybody getting along, jolly and laughing.

Stephenson: So you don't know what triggered Randy to leave?

Robertson: No, no that's kind of what flipped, flipped me out, you know. We were are standing uh, all three sitting around the fire and just talking and then he gets up, like I said, go get a beer or a cigarette. I didn't know what he got up for.

Stephenson: Michelle didn't get up or...?

Robertson: Didn't say anything. No, we were just sitting there talking, you know. He got up and next thing I know, I mean, he's running out the driveway or driving out the driveway. It was just like where's Randy going. It just freaked me out when he left. I mean, why did he leave, you know.

Stephenson: You and Randy get along?

Robertson: Great. Great. I mean, every since...

Stephenson: You all have always got along?

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Robertson: Yeah. I liked Randy, seemed like a real nice guy. I loved his kids.

Stephenson: You been a friend of them a long time?

Robertson: No. just, just met them since Michelle moved into the trailer and uh, got to know them.

Stephenson: Okay, do you know when that happened? When she moved into the trailer?

Robertson: I can look it up for you.

Stephenson: Okay.

Robertson: I...

Stephenson: When she moved in the trailer...?

Robertson: I have the lease.

Stephenson: I know. Who was with her, her two children?

Robertson: Correct, yes.

Stephenson: Okay. Was Randy living there at the time you all had this little get-together?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: How long had he been living there?

Robertson: Pretty much ever since that she had been there.

Stephenson: Okay, can you, was it six months, a year?

Robertson: No, it wasn't like, I'll have to go back and look to get an exact date but I mean, I just got their first month's rent check.

Stephenson: But Randy and Michelle and the two kids were living in the trailer?

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: Cause I had heard they had split up.

Robertson: Right.

Stephenson: And she moved out.

Robertson: Correct.

Stephenson: They used to live south of Delhi or something and she moved out and she rented a trailer and then somebody told me that just about the time she rented the trailer, Randy moved back in with her.

Robertson: That's, that's...

Stephenson: Trying to work out their marriage.

Robertson: That's right and what they both told me a lot of it had to do with, you know, regards of what Randy had done, uh, but the other, a lot of this stuff had to do with, with his mom and just getting away from them too and I think, cause he had told me, you know, that there was problems that was causing him and Michelle because of that over there between his parents.

Stephenson: Okay.

Robertson: Like I said, they seemed to be a happy family. Their kids just, you know, the morning before it was Kylie and uh, Colby and Randy fishing in a boat, you know.

Stephenson: Since they've been there, did you ever notice or did you hear about any trouble that they had over there?

Robertson: No, just, not trouble, just uh, you know, like I said, we would get together all the time. Uh, and Randy and I, you know, we would joke around. We've got grain bins out in front of the trailer and "if I wives run us off, we can move into the grain bins Randy," you know, just pick and stuff, you know, nothing ever...

Stephenson: Yeah.

Robertson: That's it.

Stephenson: Men talk.

Robertson: Men talk. No more than that.

Stephenson: Okay Noel I appreciate you coming in. It's approximately 2:40 p.m., June 19, 2007. That concludes the statement of Noel Robertson.
