> Village of Baskin Special Council Meeting September 28, 2021

The Mayor and Council of the Village of Baskin met in special session on Tuesday, September 28, 2021 at 6:00 PM at the Village of Baskin Town Hall. Present: Mayor Bobby Fife and Council Members Johnny Belton and Cary Collier, Absent: Heather Chapman.

Also Present: Town Clerk, Asst. Clerk and others.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance and opening prayer was led by Mayor Fife. Right to Speak: Sam Sheppard and Public.

New Business: Community Development Block Grant was topic of discussion. Plans for the renovation of the local town park was discussed. Town Clerk, Wanda Carroll, said the max amount of the proposed grant would be \$125,000.00 due to our village having less than 1,000 people.

The range of activities for the proposed project was discussed with the council and public. We are indeed of new playground equipment and to repair the ones we have if possible. Johnny Belton request3ed that we add some handicapped playground equipment to better accommodate all children with disabilities. Wanda Carroll asked if we could add a soft surface under each playground equipment. Others discussed the types of playground equipment such as enclosed slides, new baby swings and some sort of climbing wall if possible.

The Village of Baskin owns the property of the local town park that will be renovated, so there will be no new purchase of land necessary, therefore; we would not be displacing any person from their homes or property with this proposed project. Several LCDBG funds have been awarded to the Village of Baskin in prior years. One LCDBG awarded funds was used for the original park project back in the year 1999 when the park was built. More current funds was used for the replacement of the water lines within the village city limits and new fire hydrant purchases back in 2005 to 2007. The Village of Baskin was awarded funds from the LCDBG to complete the public bathroom facilities located at the local public park back in 2007-2008.

With no further business the mayor called for the meeting to be adjourned. Cary Collier made a motion: Johnny Belton seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. Yeas 2, Nays 0, Absent 12.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 PM.
