NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted by the Police Jury of the Parish of Franklin, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Franklin, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), on May 12, 2022, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held within the Parish on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, and that at the said election there will be submitted to all registered voters in the Parish qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Louisiana and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

**PROPOSITION
(MILLAGE RENEWAL)**

Shall the Parish of Franklin, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), levy an eight and twelve hundredths (8.12) mills tax on all property subject to taxation in the Parish (an estimated \$869,857 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of five (5) years, beginning with the year 2023 and ending with the year 2027, for the purpose of maintaining, operating and purchasing Parish equipment?

Said special election will be held at each and every polling place in the Parish of Franklin, which polls will open at six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and close at eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541.

The polling places at the precincts in the Parish are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, shall be those persons designated according to law.

The estimated cost of this election as determined by the Secretary of State based upon the provisions of Chapter 8-A of Title 18 and actual costs of similar elections is \$8,300.

Notice is further given that a portion of the monies collected from the tax described in the Proposition shall be remitted to certain state and statewide retirement systems in the manner required by law.

The said special election will be held in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 5 and Chapter 6-A of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, and the officers appointed to hold the said election, as provided in this Notice of Special Election, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La. Seismic Public Meeting Notice

To the Citizens and Landowners of NW Franklin Parish, Louisiana
Precision Energy, LLC will be conducting seismic activity north of the Crowville, LA in the Lamar Community area(s). From Lamar, the prospect extends East to Bayou Macon to the Parish line and West to Turkey Creek in Franklin Parish. The seismic area more specifically is located in Sections 25, 35, 36, T16N, R8E. Sections 25-36, in T16N, R9E and Sections 29-32, in T16N, R10E. Sections 1 & 2, in T15N, R8E and sections 1-12 in T15N, R8E in Franklin Parish, LA.
The survey will begin approx. 10/14/22 and last until on or before 12/1/2022, subject to weather and crop harvesting. In the event of delays, the survey could be extended to the fall of 2023 after crop harvest.
