Mr. Davis then inquired about another issue concerning the front entrance to the school. At this time the office has implemented a window for parents to use, the problem with that, is there is a pallet being used as a platform. There needs to be a more permanent solution to that. Mr. Gullatt is hoping that this is a temporary solution until the entrances to schools are reopened. Mr. Gullatt, went over other items that will need to be addressed during the summer months, which include, the canopy at Baskin is rotten, HGW has damage from the recent hurricane that will need to be addressed. Also, the dirt pile behind the football stadium is being moved. Mr. Eddie Ray Bryan, added that, at Fort Jr. High, there is loose siding at the front of the gym. Mr. Gullatt added that Doug has gotten a contractor checking the roofs at the campuses. He updated everyone, that Mr. Guice is aware of the damage at Crowville School, from the ice storm. He has the paperwork and checking to see if the work was warranted.

Summer school will be going on at every school this year. This will push back the summer maintenance activities, scheduled, to later in the summer.  
With no other matters to cover, Mrs. Nichols adjourned the Maintenance Committee meeting.

The Finance Committee Meeting was called to order by, Dr. Jacqueline Johnson. Mrs. Boquet reported to the committee, due to a computer problem she was unable to complete her financial report. Mrs. Boquet will present the budget report at the regular meeting, May 6, 2021.

We are working on the budget for next year, our plan is to advertise in May for the public hearing in June. Mrs. Boquet, informed the board that the business office is providing information to the Department of Education to show that we are maintaining the same amount of funding in our general fund to support the federal money through special Ed., which is called our Maintenance of Effort. Bond payments have been made that was purchased in 2017. It is a 5-year bond.
