Water Treatment Change Coming Soon to Residents of the BROWN-

Date: MARCH 11, 2025 Brownville Water System monitors the disinfectant residual in the distribution system on a daily basis. This measurement tells us whether we

are effectively disinfecting the water supply. The disinfectant residual is the amount of chlorine or chloramines in the distribution system. Randy C. Hammons, P.E., Lazenby & Associates, Inc. Board Meeting called to order at 11:00 A.M. by Donald F. Leach, Pres-

ident. President Leach asked the Board Members to review the September 9, 2024, Board Meeting Minutes. Following a brief review of the meeting minutes, Commissioner Glover moved that the minutes be accepted as

Commissioner Sanders seconded the motion and the minutes were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

President Leach recognized Mr. Ricky McMullen, Manager and requested that he present an update on status of the proposed sewer rate study developed by FCS Group at the request of the Louisiana Water Sector Commission. Mr. McMullen advised the Board of Commissioners that he had spoken to Ms. Traci Watts, Director of Local Government Assistance, Office of Community Development, and expressed the Board's displeasure with results of the rate study developed by FCS Group and the lack of cooperation and communication with the FCS Group, particularly with their inability to fully understand the current financial condition of WOSD No. 5 and how this may impact the proposed rate increase. Ms. Watts stated she would discuss these concerns with the FCS Group and report back to

No formal action was taken on the rate study by the Board at this time. President Leach recognized Ricky McMullen, Manager and Randy Hammons, P.E. and requested that they report on the status of the Water Sector Program Projects and Capital Outlay Projects currently under construction within the District.

Mr. McMullen and Mr. Hammons reported that two (2) Water Sector Program Projects remain active but that all construction has been completed. L & A, Inc. Project 21E052.00 Valley Hills Subdivision Pump Station and Force Main - the 45-day lien period ended September 30, 2024, but the "clear lien" certificate has not been submitted by the Contractor. L & A, Inc. Project 21E048.00/22E035.00 Washington Street Gravity Sewer Slip Lining is currently in the 45-day lien period. It will be the Contractor's responsibility to obtain a "clear lien" certificate at the end of the lien

Mr. Hammons reported that two (2) Capital Outlay Projects remain active but that all construction has been completed. L & A, Inc. Project 21E010.01 Country Estates West Subdivision Pump Station and Force Main to Lift Station "G-1" - the 45-day lien period ended October 5, 2024, but the "clear lien" certificate has not been submitted by the Contractor. L & A, Inc. Project 17E037.00 Gravity Sewer Pipe Bursting was determined to be "Substantially Complete" after a final inspection held on September 19, 2024, and the Contractor's 45-day lien period began on October 8, 2024. It will be the Contractor's responsibility to obtain a "clear lien" certificate at the end of the lien period.

The Water Sector Program and Capital Outlay project status presentation was for information only at this time. No formal action by the Board was necessary.

President Leach requested that Mr. McMullen present the WOSD No. 5Balance Sheet as of August 31, 2024 and the WOSD No. 5 Profit and Loss Budget Performance Sheet for August, 2024. These items are informational items only and no formal Board action is required.

President Leach requested that District Manager McMullen present the WOSD No. 5 Cash Receipts and Distribution Report for September, 2024 and October, 2024.

Following a review and discussion of the various expenditures and receipts, Commissioner Glover moved that the financial report be accepted and that the receipts and expenses be approved.

Motion seconded by Commissioner Sanders. Motion approved by a unanimous voice vote.
