

Before Hurricane Katrina, Puccio had an Elvis Museum at his home in Chalmette.

Unfortunately, when Katrina brought 20 feet of water into his home, he lost all of the mementos he's spent a lifetime gathering.

Never one to give up on any of his dreams, Puccio,

like many Louisianians, rebuilt. He now shares his love of music with everyone he encounters. One of his favorite things to do, he says, is sit in the common area at the Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs Southeast Louisiana Veterans Home and listen to the jukebox play old records.

Puccio said likes to share tidbits of his days spent hobnobbing with celebrities, his passion for food, and his love of all things 1950's, to his new friends and fellow Veterans at the Reserve home.

He has been at the home for three months now and said, "It's going really well here," as he taps his feet to the beat of his own music.

Business Director Juanita Duke presented the 2017-18 Financial Report (unaudited) for fiscal year ended June 30, 2018 to the Board. Copies of her report were provided the Board that included all funds of the School Board and the total budgeted revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year compared to actual performance. Mrs. Duke began her report stating this is a preliminary end-of-year report subject to final adjustments and accruals to be made for 2017-18 financial reporting. She reported total revenues in the General Fund of \$141.7 million, 99.3% of prior fiscal year revenues. Expenditures were \$141.9 million, about 1% more than the prior fiscal year and 98.5% of the final budget. Currently, the reduction in fund balance for the year is \$760,000 before adjustments, an improvement compared to the budgeted reduction of \$3.4 million. General Fund preliminary ending fund balance is reported to be \$20.0 million as of June 30, 2018.

School District #1 M&O Fund Sales Tax total revenue collections are \$7.6 million or 102.1% of the final budget. Total annual expenditures are \$7.8 million with an additional \$200,000 in transfers from the General Fund to cover expenditures in the Equipment Repairs & Maintenance fund category. Excess of revenues over expenditures of \$153,956 is added to ending fund balance, which is reported to be \$18.7 million, before adjustments. The 1968 Sales Tax, 1995 Sales Tax, West Ouachita Sales Tax annual revenue average about 98% of prior fiscal year revenue. The ending fund balance of the 1968 Sales Tax and 1995 Sales Tax is \$1.8 million and \$6.0 million, respectively. The West Ouachita Sales Tax fund has expenditures of \$1.4 million for the fiscal year and transfers for debt service of \$9.2 million, ending the year with excess of revenue over expenditures of \$1.7 million and an ending fund balance of \$12.3 million, before final

Child Nutrition Program Funds total revenue collections are \$10.9 million with expenditures of \$9.5 million, leaving an excess of funds of \$1.4 million that will be added to fund balance and designated for equipment replacement according to Board policy. The current ending fund balance is \$5.6 million, before adjustments.

Grant Funds total revenue is currently \$15.3 million with \$15.0 million in expenditures. Mrs. Duke reported a deficiency of \$926,450 in grants that is attributed to final receivables yet to be booked at the time of this report to close out the fiscal year.

INTERNAL SERVICE FUNDS:

Self-Insurance (Workers Comp/Casualty) total expenses for the year are \$728,686, before closing adjustments. Transfers in from the General Fund were \$600,000. The total net assets were reduced \$65,000 for the year and currently reported at \$2.37 million, before adjustments.

Centralized Printing collected billed charges of \$362,166 and incurred expenses of \$605,382. Transfers in of \$185,000 was received periodically throughout the fiscal year from the General Fund to offset staffing expenses not funded by billed charges. This fund has no net assets as of June 30,

DEBT SERVICE FUNDS no significant change other than accruing monthly debt service payments for bond payments scheduled for September 1, 2018 for East Ouachita West Ouachita and School District No. 1 bonding districts.

CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS:

East 2015 Bond Construction has ended the fiscal year with a remaining fund balance of \$923,551 and West 2015 Bond Construction with a remaining balance of \$3.5 million.

Mrs. Duke concluded her report stating the final audited financial statements will be presented to the Board by independent auditors in early 2019. Whereby, Carey Walker moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, that the Board approve the preliminary June 30, 2018 Financial Report (unaudited) as presented by Business Director Juanita Duke. President Hicks offered a brief period for public comment and motion unanimously carried. ABSENT: John Russell

Business Director Juanita Duke provided the Board with a copy of the Ouachita Parish School Board 2018-19 Annual Operating Budget for the fiscal period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 for consideration. A summary of the financial performance of the Board for this fiscal year was mailed to members of the Board by Mrs. Duke for review before today's meeting and the necessary advertisements have been made in the official journal and the public hearing on the budget was held at 11:00 a.m. immediately

Mrs. Duke informed the Board and those in attendance that the public had an opportunity to review and inspect the 2018-19 Annual Operating Budget prior to the public hearing and the requirements for presenting the budget to the Board for adoption have been met.

Ms. Duke recommended a resolution adopting the annual operating budget which sets forth the revenues, expenditures, fund balances, and designation and the implementation thereof, for the General Fund, Special Revenue, and Debt Service funds of the Ouachita Parish School Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019 summarized as follows:

General Fund balance is currently projected to be 13.33% of budgeted expenditures at June 30, 2019, which is within the Board's fund balance maintenance policy.

President Hicks opened the meeting for a discussion with the Board on the possibility of changing the Board meeting schedule from two (2) meetings per month to only one per month for the remainder of this year. Following a discussion, Greg Manley moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, that the Board change their meeting schedule from two (2) meetings per month to one meeting per month for the remainder of this year to be held every second Tuesday of each month, alternating the time of the meetings between 6:00 p.m. and 12:00 noon, with the first meeting in October starting at 6:00 p.m. and the November meeting at 12:00 noon. From this time forward, the monthly meetings will be alternated between the 6:00 p.m. and 12:00 noon times. Due to the "Fall Break" falling on the second Tuesday in October, the next meeting will be held on the third Tuesday, October 16, 2018, at six (6:00) p.m. The next consecutive meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at twelve (12:00) noon. The Board will be allowed to call additional "special" meetings as needed. President Hicks offered a brief moment for public comment and motion carried unanimously. ABSENT: John Russell

On the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones, Tommy Comeaux moved, seconded by Scott Robinson, that the Board allow Mr. Jones to include an order of 81/2 x 11 pastel colored copy paper to the original white copy paper order previously approved in the Board meeting of August 28, 2018 under [Bid No. 21-19]. President Hicks offered a brief moment for public comment and motion carried unanimously. ABSENT: John Russell

Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher reported that the new roof replacement project at Ouachita Parish High School is 60% complete and hopefully will be finished the end of this month. The crew is working during the night, but the afternoon and evening rain is slowing them down. The rubber floor in the locker room at West Ouachita High School still hasn't been installed and the lockers have not come in. The company that is installing the floor won't issue a warranty until the concrete gets to a certain level as it dries. By then, maybe the lockers will come in. Sterlington High School is experiencing a delay in the laundry room project due to the installation of the fire alarm system.

On the recommendation of Special Projects/Safety Coordinator Kenneth Slusher, Tommy Comeaux moved, seconded by Greg Manley, that the Board accept the low base bid from Mann's Construction, Inc. of \$5,515,000 including Alt. #1 (repave parking lot on site) in the amount of \$125,000 for a total cost of \$5,640,000 for the renovation of the future central office complex, formerly the OPAC building on North 7th Street in West Monroe [Bid No. 19-19] that will be funded with remaining Series 1995 West Ouachita Bond proceeds, Westside Sales Tax funds, and proceeds from the sale of three properties: the Central Office at 100 Bry St., Title I Media Center at 701 St. John St., and the IT building at 800 Jackson St. The estimated budget for this project was \$7.1 million. President Hicks offered a brief moment for public discussion and motion unanimously carried. ABSENT: John Russell

On the recommendation of Purchasing Agent Bobby Jones, Tommy Comeaux moved, seconded by Greg Manley, that the Board grant permission to bid HVAC Equipment for Robinson, Highland & Calhoun (gym) Elementary Schools, funded with M&O funds with a budget of \$196,500.00 [Bid No. 27-19]. A brief moment for public comments was offered by President Hicks and motion carried unanimously. ABSENT: John Russell

President Hicks announced the Adopt-A-School Task Force annual Fall Meet & Greet meeting is Tuesday, September 18 at 8:30 a.m., West Monroe High – Edgewood Building on 501 Travis Street.

At this time, Dr. Coker shared a proud moment brought to his attention in the stadium at West Ouachita High School this morning while attending a patriotic commemoration service in honor of the victims of "911" and how impressed he was with the performance of the WOHS's ROTC cadets, their officers and staff. The ceremony was held on behalf of the students, staff and guests of WOHS in remembrance of the victims that died on September 11, 2001 seventeen years ago when a foreign Taliban group attacked and destroyed the two World Trade Center buildings in New York, N.Y. and damaged the Pentagon building in Arlington, Virginia, killing over 2,000 people under these two surprise attacks. Since most of these students were not born 17 years ago, Dr. Coker was amazed at the reverence and respect these students demonstrated during the ceremony. He also observed the great job the ROTC officers did in sharing remnants of history with the crowd today while remembering those that lost their lives. Dr. Coker gave appreciation to the WOHS - ROTC unit's contribution and interest shown while representing Ouachita Parish schools in a way that made sure everything possible was being done to teach our students the truth about that day in September when the world stood still. In conclusion, Dr. Coker remarked that he is very proud of every WOHS student's emotional display of absolute attention and respect to this special time in history.
