Tech linebacker honored

RUSTON, La. – Senior linebacker Trey Baldwin earned Conference USA Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors after setting a new Alamodome record with a career-high 18 tackles in Louisiana Tech's 27-26 loss at UTSA on Saturday.

The Orange, Texas, native's 18 tackles tied for the seventh most in a single game nationally this season and were the most by a Bulldog since Jay Dudley had 18 against Fresno State in 2010.

His 18 tackles were the most by a Bulldog in a road game since

Bobby Gray at Auburn in 2001. Baldwin had 14 solo tackles against the Roadrunners which was the second most in a single game in the FBS this season. His 14 solo tackles were the most since Adrien Cole had 15 at Nevada in 2011.

At UTSA, Baldwin recorded 2.0 tackles for loss, including his first career sack, his second career interception which he returned for 10 yards and one pass breakup.

Baldwin now ranks 12th in the nation in tackles per game at 11.4

and 24th in solo tackles per game at 6.8

UTSA sophomore RB Sincere McCormick was named the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose National Player of the Week for his performance in the 27-26 win against Louisiana Tech, SPORTyler announced Tuesday.

McCormick registered his second straight and fourth 100-yard rushing game of the season to help lead the Roadrunners to a 27-26 win against the Bulldogs on Saturday night at the Alamodome.
