

# Griffin returns to ACCS

Adams County Christian School hired a new girls basketball coach.

But they can skip the tour of the school and facilities.

Brandy Hall Griffin, who played for her mother, Melanie Hall, at Trinity Episcopal before serving as an assistant coach for her mother at AC, has been named as the new girls basketball head coach at ACCS.

“I am super excited to be back home,” Griffin said.

Griffin brings more than 16 years of experience to AC. While assisting her mother with the junior high and high school girls teams, Griffin also coached third and fourth grade girls teams.

In 2018, Griffin was hired as girls basketball coach at Centreville Academy, leading the Lady Tigers to the state championship in 2020.

Griffin joined Madison-Ridgeland Academy in 2022, assisting Stephen Force, and winning a state and overall title in 2023. MRA won the overall title this past season.

Griffin and her husband, Beau Griffin, have two children —Sadie Page and Connor.

The hiring process was made possible after Beau received a new position at Energy in Vicksburg.

“Beau will be closer to his family in Lafayette, as well,” Brandy said.

Griffin said she knew how good ACCS was back when he was a sophomore when AC and Trinity played in the state

semifinals.

“I want to change the culture to even better than what it used to be,” Griffin said. “It doesn’t happen overnight. But I know those girls are very coachable, and want to be successful. They just need to be pushed, and need to be coached. I am so fortunate to have worked with someone like Coach Force, who enhanced my knowledge of the game. We have to make sure they have the proper work ethic. I know I can get the best out of them.”

“Brandy was one of the best players around our area in her playing days,” said ACCS administrator David King. “She has been on the bench of one of the premier programs in the state the last few years. She loves Natchez and AC. She will be successful for a long time with us.”

Shall the Parish of Concordia, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), continue to levy a 10 mills tax (an estimated \$1,775,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year) on all property subject to taxation in the Parish for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2028 and ending with the year 2037, for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and/or operating public drainage works and improvements and public buildings and facilities in the Parish, including the acquisition and purchase of necessary equipment and materials for said purposes?

The said special election will be held at each and every polling place in the Parish, which polls will open at seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. and close at eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541.

The polling places at the precincts in the Parish are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, shall be those persons designated according to law.

The estimated cost of this election as determined by the Secretary of State based upon the provisions of Chapter 8-A of Title 18 and actual costs of

similar elections is \$33,700.

Notice is further given that a portion of the monies collected from the tax described in the Proposition shall be remitted to certain state and statewide retirement systems in the manner required by law.
