SECTION 1. Canvass. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in Crowville Fire District, State of Louisiana, on SATURDAY, MARCH 26, 2022 (the "Election"), to authorize the levy of a special tax therein pursuant to the following proposition (the "Proposition"):

PROPOSITION (MILLAGE RENEWAL) Shall Crowville Fire District, State of Louisiana (the "District"), levy a four (4) mills tax on all property subject to taxation in the District, (an estimated \$95,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period often (10) years, beginning with the year 2023 and ending with the year 2032, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and/or operating facilities and equipment to provide fire protection in and for the District, including the purchase of fire trucks and other fire fighting equipment?

This Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns thereof.
