NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN APPLICATION FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on January 24, 2022, in the City Council Chambers, the City of Hastings, Nebraska, will hold a public hearing concerning an application to the Nebraska Department of Economic Development for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). This grant is available to local governments for community/economic development activities.

The City of Hastings is requesting \$727,000.00 for:

- Project Activity #18A – Direct Financial Assistance to For-Profit– \$720,000
- Project Activity #21A – General Administration - \$7,000

The City of Hastings is requesting stated CDBG funds for an expansion of the Pacha Soap Co., to purchase new equipment and fund working capital to expand production capacity at the Hastings plant located at 317 South Elm Avenue in Hastings, Nebraska. Twenty-four (24) jobs full time equivalent (FTE) jobs will be created as a result of the project, primarily benefiting low to moderate income persons through the national objective of low-moderate income/jobs (LMJ). The total project cost is approximately \$1,447,000. Matching funds of approximately \$720,000 for the stated project will be provided from a non-bank lender. There will be no displacement of people as a result of these CDBG activities.

The grant application will be available for public inspection at the offices of the City of Hastings, 220 N. Hastings Avenue. All interested parties are invited to attend this public hearing at which time you will have an opportunity to be heard regarding the grant application. Written and oral testimony will also be accepted at the public hearing scheduled for 5:30 pm, Monday, January 24, 2022, in the City Council Chambers, 220 N. Hastings, Hastings, NE. Written comments addressed to Mayor Corey Stutte, at the City of Hastings, 220 N. Hastings, Hastings, NE 68901 will be accepted if received on or before 12:00 p.m., Monday, January 24, 2022.
