ORDINANCE NO. 82626-1
An Ordinance Relating to the Amendment
of the Budget for the Kentucky River Area Development District for Fiscal Year 2026-2027

WHEREAS, KRS Chapter 91A requires that each Municipality accept a budget for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky River Area Development District, Perry County, Kentucky has previously adopted a budget for fiscal year 2026-2027, as a proposed plan for raising and spending money for specified programs, functions, activities or objectives during the fiscal year so as to provide for efficient financial administration, and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky River Area Development District has received an ARC grant in the amount of \$1,592,468 in connection with the Chappell Dairy Building Renovations Project; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky River Area Development District desires to document said transfer and to amend the 2026-2027 budget to show the inclusion of said funds into the budget and the expenditure of said funds from the budget,

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KENTUCKY RIVER AREA DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, PERRY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The budget of the Kentucky River Area Development District for fiscal year 2026-2027 is hereby amended to allow for the inclusion into the budget for the Kentucky River Area Development District of a \$1,592,468 ARC grant, received in connection with the Chappell Dairy Building Renovations Project.

Section 2. That the budget for the Kentucky River Area Development District for fiscal year 2026-2027 is hereby amended to allow for the expenditure of the aforementioned \$1,592,468 in Appalachian Regional Commission loan funds for use on the Chappell Dairy Building Renovations Project.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect following its passage and upon publication
