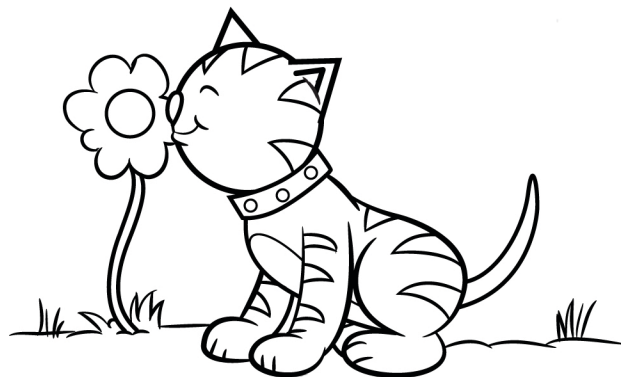


A Drawing lesson from the
Drawing with Mark episode:

Let's Draw a cute Cat!



We can use our basic shapes:
Circle Square Triangle



Here is what our finished drawing will look like.
Start with your pencil, crayon or marker.
Sketch lightly and have fun. Let's start!



1. Start with a **CIRCLE** shape for the Cat's head. Then add Action Line that will sweep along and help create the tail. Use basic shape **TRIANGLES** to start the ears.

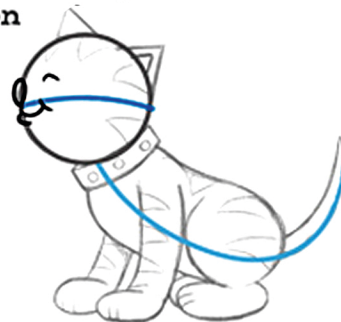
2. Now draw the Cat's nose. The bottom of the nose touches the foundation line which also touches the end of the Cat's ear on the right. Finish drawing rest of face.

Add a foundation line on the head to help line up everything on the Cat's face.

3. Draw the basic shape circles for the body. Then link them up with just two lines. This creates the shape of our Cat friend.



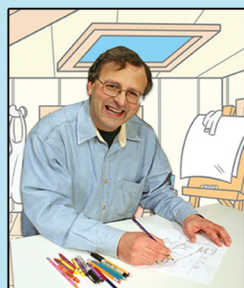
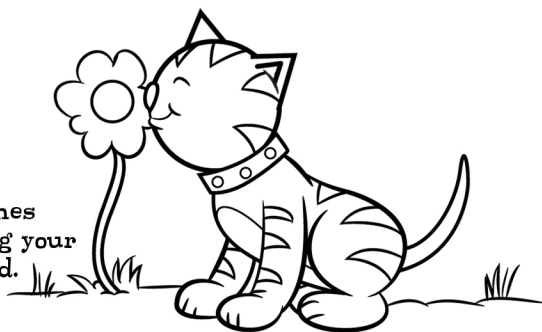
4. Add some foundation and structure for the Cat's "elbows": Use circles to create the volume of the Cat's arm. This way, we know how wide the arms will be and understand where the joints of the animal will be.



5. Tubes and ovals help create the legs and paws.



6. Add stripes for fun. In the end, the basic shapes used as your foundation lines will be erased. (like on the Cat's back leg). Yet they're still there invisibly, giving your drawing a good solid "foundation." Then use simple lines to draw a background. Make up your own background if you wish. Create adventures with your character!
