Cultural Facilities and Capital Resources Grant

*Special Guest: Randall Reid-Smith, West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History
Mayor Chris Tatum, Village of Barboursville*

Barboursville Middle School has been awarded the Cultural Facilities and Capital Resource Grant, a program through the West Virginia Division of Culture and History and WV Commission on the Arts. The grant provides support for the acquisition, construction and renovation of arts venues, accessibility improvements and capital purchases of durable equipment. The Village of Barboursville will also provide supplemental funds in the amount of \$10,000 to provide upgrades to the auditorium at Barboursville Middle School.

Save the Music Foundation Grant

Huntington East Middle School is one of eight middle schools in West Virginia that has been awarded a 2022 Save the Music Foundation Grant in the amount of \$40,000. The grant will provide for free instruments, free instructional materials, 36 free music stands and a stand holder for each school and free clinics for band directors. The Save the Music program currently operates in 112 West Virginia middle schools in all 55 counties.

Developmental Therapy Center, Inc., a local not-for-profit organization, who has provided services to Cabell County Public Schools students for over 35 years, is the preferred vendor. They are a resident vendor familiar with the schools, administrators, teachers and most of all the students. They can assure staffing and have demonstrated an understanding of West Virginia Policy 2419, *The Regulations for the Education of Exceptional Students*, and how to apply policy. Because they are local, DTC staff are readily available to answer questions from parents and teachers and can provide day to day supervision and oversight of therapists they employ. The proposal included direct/indirect therapy sessions, Medicaid billing, obtaining/tracking scripts, writing IEPs and amendments, requisition and tracking of equipment and supplies, and evaluations. They also provide their own onsite supervision.
