

# CURBSIDE RECYCLING IS COMING TO HUNTINGTON OCT. 1!

## HOW TO SIGN UP:

Residents can sign up for the Rumpke Huntington Recycling Program by choosing ONE of these options:

- Have your name, address, phone number and email address ready.
- Complete the form at [rumpke.cc/huntingtonrecycles](http://rumpke.cc/huntingtonrecycles)
- For those with no internet access, call Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 extension 8755 and tell the agent you want to sign up for the Huntington Recycles program. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday, 8 AM to 5 PM.

## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

- Residents must opt into this voluntary program. A minimum number of participants must sign up, in order for the program to be viable. Sign up options are listed above.
- Residents will receive a Rumpke 95-gallon cart for recyclables. Material must be placed loose in the container (no bags) and all recycling material must be inside of the cart.
- Recyclables should be mixed together and placed loose inside the cart. NO plastic bags. Cart must be placed at the curb.
- Recycling containers contaminated with trash will NOT be collected as trash or recycling.
- Recycling will be collected every other week, unless there is a holiday or inclement weather prevents collection.

## PAYMENT:

- \$10 per month, payment is collected 6 months in advance.
- There is a \$10 delivery fee for the 95-gallon cart. If sign up occurs after October 1, the delivery fee is \$20.
- City of Huntington residents will be eligible for a \$5 per month credit on their city refuse bill if they sign up for curbside recycling. More information coming soon.

Cardboard should fit inside cart.

### PLASTICS

Bottles, jugs, tubs & cups



Reattach lid.  
Yogurt and fruit cups OK.

### METAL CANS & CUPS



Non-hazardous,  
non-flammable material only.

### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



Any color.

### CARTONS



Remove caps and straws.
