On 02/18/2020, I received a Department of Children Services Referral stating that a minor child, Evelyn Boswell (age 15 months) had not been seen since before Christmas 2019. Myself and CPS case worker James Lewis made contact with Megan Boswell, mother and sole legal custodian of the minor child, Evelyn, at _____ and asked her where we could locate Evelyn Boswell. Megan Boswell told us that Evelyn was with the child's father, Ethan Perry. She further stated that she was supposed to meet him on 02/19/2019 at 4 p.m. at Ingles parking lot in Colonial Heights to exchange custody. After further investigation, detectives determined that Ethan Perry is actively enlisted in the United States Army and is presently stationed at Fort Polk, Louisiana and did not have possession of Evelyn.

Through investigation, it was determined that Megan Boswell made the false statement to law enforcement in response to a legitimate inquiry by Law Enforcement concerning a material fact about an offense or with the intent to hinder Law Enforcement from locating Evelyn Boswell. All the above occurred in the boundaries of Sullivan County.
